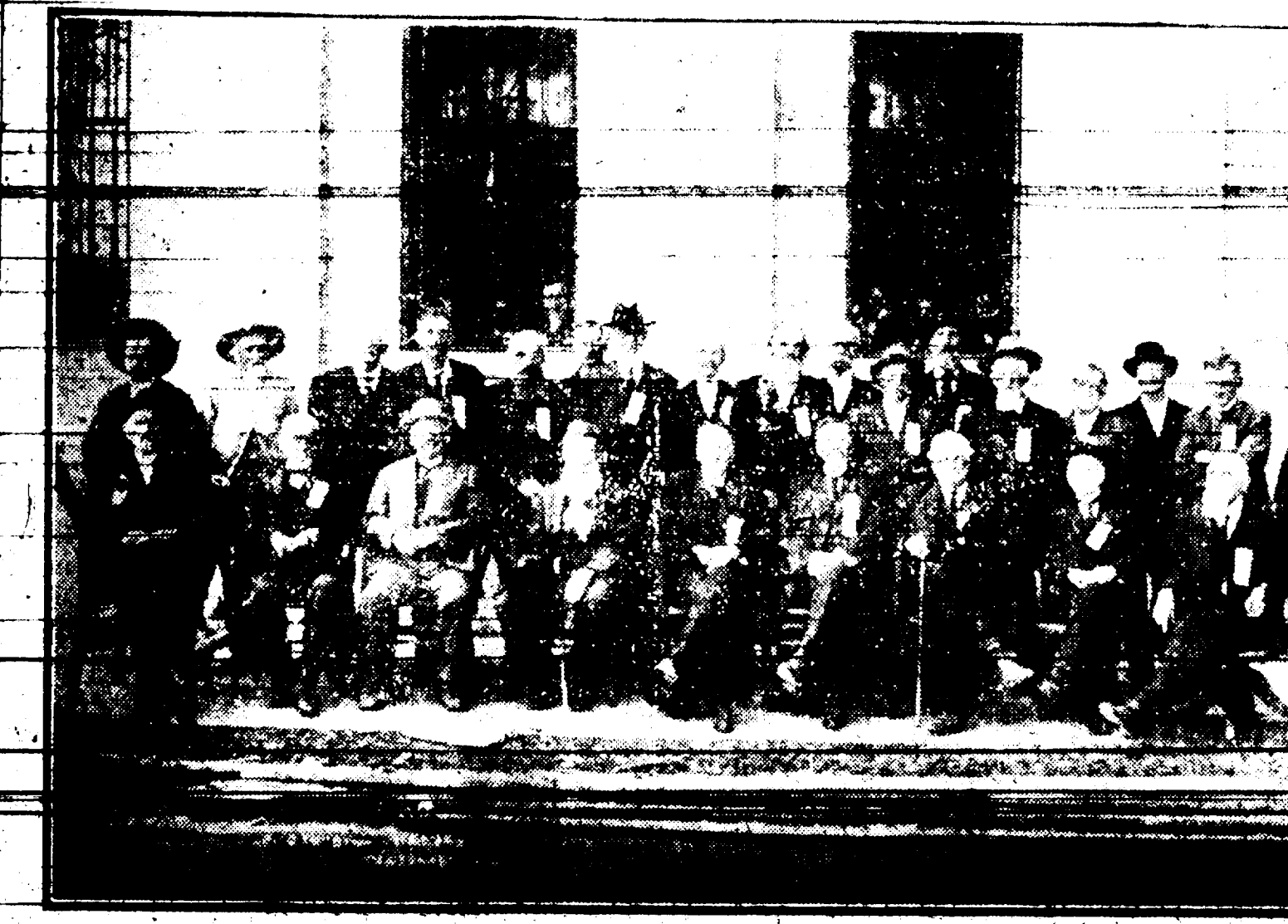

EWELL CAMP OF CONFEDERATE VETS. ORGANIZED MARCH 26, 1890

In Two Weeks, Membership Has Reached One Fifty Six, and is Growing by Daily Accretion.

Ewell Camp, of United Confederate Veterans was organized in Manassas, Va., on March 26, 1890, with a membership of 64, with the following officers: J. E. Hazzell, Commander; R. H. Hooper, 1st Lieut. Commander; John A. Brawner, 2nd Lieut. Commander; Geo. W. Nutt, adjutant; W. W. Kinchloe, treasurer; H. F. Lynn, officer of the day; B. L. Pridmore, vidette; and Dr. J. S. Powell, surgeon.

The object of the organization is to epitomize in the true spirit of fellowship, benevolence and magnanimity which pervades every sentence embodied in the creed which is spread upon its records: "To perpetuate the memories of our fallen comrades; to minister as far as practicable to the wants of those who were permanently disabled in the service; to preserve and maintain that sentiment of fraternity, born of hardships and dangers shared in the march, the bivouac and on the battlefield; not to prolong the animosities engendered by the war; but to extend to our survivors, on every fitting occasion, courtesies which are always proper between soldiers and which, in our case, a common citizenship demands at our hands."

At customary periods of strewing flowers upon the graves and paying tributes of praise to the Confederate dead, this noble band of heroes is ever present, so far as health and bodily strength will allow, with loving hands, symbolizing hearts and patriotic voices.

GENERAL YOUNG MADE COMMANDER

GENERAL TRIMBLE'S INVITATION

Blue and Gray War Mergers in a Celebration at Gettysburg in July, 1913 - Invited

General Bennett Young, of Louisville, Ky., commander of the Army of Tennessee, was chosen commander-in-chief of the United Confederate Veterans at the recent reunion in Mason, Ga.

The invitation of General Trimble, commander-in-chief of the Grand Army of the Republic, to merge the Blue and the Gray in a celebration at Gettysburg in July, 1913, was unanimously and enthusiastically accepted.

One or two delegates declared that the official endorsement of the convention was not in conformity with the constitution of the United Confederate Veterans, and that they did not think it desirable that the breach between the Union and Confederate soldiers was forever healed; that nowhere could be found in the terms of the Confederacy, animus toward the soldiers of the Union, and that the Gettysburg reunion would forever wipe out what fragments of ill feeling there might possibly be left.

This action of the United Confederate Veterans is, in every sense commendable, as the passage of fifty years, since the great struggle between the contending armies of the North and the South which terminated at Appomattox, should be sufficient to dispel all animosity, especially from a Christian standpoint.
