VIRGINIA'S GAME LAW

FULL TEXT OF THE STATUTE.

Approved May 14, 1903. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia, That chapter ninety-nine of the Code of Virginia, entitled "Hundred and eighty-seven, be amended and re-enacted so as to read as follows: Section 9070 (a). When and how unlawful to hunt, et cetera.—1. It shall be unlawful for any person to shoot at, kill or capture any wild water fowl or wild turkey at any time during the night in this state, or at any time to capture them in traps or nets or other contrivances, or to use reflectors or other lights, or to use artificial island in detecting or capturing, or shooting of wild fowl or game of any kind, or to hunt or shoot on any land or water in this state with a gun larger than an eight bore. All snare traps, nets, traps or reflectors, or other unlawful appliances so used or found in the possession of any person shall be seized by any game warden or other officer and held by him as evidence, but the same shall not be destroyed except by the order of the court or justice having jurisdiction, upon warrants duly issued, which said court or justice shall, upon satisfactory evidence of the guilt of the party, or of the unlawful nature of the article seized, order the same to be destroyed. The possession of any of said guns, snare traps, nets, traps, reflectors or other unlawful appliances shall be prima facie evidence of the guilt of the person in whose possession they are found.

TURKEYS AND PARTRIDGES.

2. It shall be unlawful for any person to hunt, kill or capture in any manner, or buy, offer for sale, or have in possession any wild turkeys, pheasants or grouse, quail or partridges or woodcock East of the Blue Ridge Mountains between February the first and November the first, and West of the Blue Ridge Mountains between December the thirty-first and November the first, or to track any of them in snow except wild turkeys, or trap or net them at any time to destroy their nests, eggs or young at any time, or kill, chase or capture, or buy, offer for sale, or have in possession any wild deer between January the first and October the first, or to track or hunt them in snow, or to kill or capture, or buy, offer for sale, or have in possession, any winter wild water fowl between April the first and October the first, or summer or wood ducks between January the first and August the first, or any wild and feral, gallinules, plovers, snipe and quail, wild turkeys, snipe or curlews, between January the first and July twentieth, or robins between April the first and February the first. The possession of any of said game birds or game animals, or parts thereof, protected by the laws of this state, during the season in which it is unlawful to hunt, kill or capture the same, shall be prima facie evidence of the guilt of the party in whose possession they are found.

ISSUE SEARCH WARRANT.

5. Any court, judge or justice having jurisdiction over the offense, if satisfied upon affidavits that there is reasonable cause to believe that any wild water fowl, game birds, game animals or song or insectivorous birds, or parts thereof, taken, killed, shipped, or about to be shipped, in transit, contrary to the laws of this state or of the United States, are being concealed or stored in any place, shall issue a search warrant and cause search therefor to be made in any such place, and to that end may, after demand and refusal, cause any building enclosure or car to be entered, and any apartment in which it is believed that game is concealed to be examined by any of said wardens or other officers executing the warrant: provided that the issuance and execution of such search warrants shall be in accordance with the issuance and execution of search warrants in other cases as provided by law.

NON-RESIDENT LICENSE.

2. Upon the personal application of any non-resident to the clerk of the Circuit Court of any county in which he first begins to hunt, such clerk shall, upon the payment of ten dollars, issue to such non-resident a hunting license, using a form to be prescribed by the Auditor of Public Accounts for that purpose, entitling him to hunt and kill wild water fowl, deer, turkeys, pheasants or grouse, woodcock, partridges, quail, and other game birds during the open season in the six months next following and subject to any restrictions now existing against or which may hereafter be imposed upon residents of this state. The clerk shall retain fifty cents as his fee for issuing such license, and the residue he shall account for to the Auditor of Public Accounts, unless otherwise provided for by law. Such license shall not be transferable.

NON-RESIDENT LICENSE.

3. It shall be unlawful, except as hereinafter provided, to ship or transport, from this state, whether alive or dead, water fowl, deer, turkeys, pheasants or grouse, woodcock, partridges, quail, or other game birds or any deer or venison, killed or captured within this state, nor shall the same be killed, captured or possessed with intent to ship or transport from this state.

NON-RESIDENT LICENSE.

4. Any person authorized to hunt under the laws of this state may, during the open season, take with him out of the state, either in his personal possession or as his baggage, not in a closed package, but exposed to view, thirty wild water fowl, fifty quail or partridges, ten pheasants or grouse, three wild turkeys, one deer.

NON-RESIDENT LICENSE.

5. All fines and penalties imposed and collected under the provisions of this chapter shall be paid to the Commonwealth, and in addition to said fines and penalties, there shall be assessed

### The McCue Murder Case.

(Special from Charlottesville.) CHARLOTTESVILLE, Va., Oct. 30, 1904.

Every new stage of development in the case of J. Samuel McCue, charged with wife murder, has been followed this week with intense interest by the citizens of Charlottesville. The tide of public feeling is very strongly set against the prisoner, and now, indeed, of his townspeople think him innocent.

A venire of fifty jurors was summoned from Petersburg, Va., and on Tuesday of this week the work of impaneling the jury was begun. So rigid was the questioning and so careful the selection that of this number only nine were deemed eligible to serve. The difficulty of obtaining the requisite number greatly retarded the progress of the trial.

A new venire was being selected day after tomorrow, but on Wednesday afternoon three or four only of this forty or fifty, to be summoned, had been chosen.

While the impaneling of the jury was in progress on Tuesday the court room was packed to overflowing. Quietly, and with apparent coolness, the prisoner sat in the dock, paying little heed to the obvious crowd around him, but listening attentively to every word addressed to the jurors.

Mr. J. Samuel McCue, throughout his entire imprisonment, has preserved his composure, and seems firmly convinced that his innocence will be ultimately established. His cell is decorated with photographs of his children, and on the wall constantly before his eyes reposes the portrait of his murdered wife, to whom he often refers in terms of endearment.
