

turpike, a New York regiment, I think the Fifth, has a small monument placed where that regiment stood and fought. Beyond Groveton is the railroad where many Federals were killed in the Second Manassas. In the Second Manassas, the Confederate and Federal forces occupied different positions, or just the reverse of the first battle.

HOSPITALITY

"At the pavilion the Daughters of Bull Run Chapter had prepared lunches and about 2 o'clock a crowd of veterans and others met there. The program consisted of music by the United States Cavalry Band and drills by a cavalry squad, speeches by veterans of the Blue and Gray, recitations by young ladies and the singing of Dixie.

MAKES SPEECH

"The writer was called on for a speech and in the course of his speech said that at the time of the battle his command was on Virginia soil at Norfolk, but that some of Georgia's best men fell on that field, General Francis Bartow, whom I knew, and two of my schoolmates, Lee Lamar and Cook Ballard, members of the Eighth Georgia Regiment.

GRAVES ON MATHEWS' FARM

"The little speech was well received and as I stepped down, a gentleman came up to me and said: 'You know Lee Lamar? There is on my farm a small headstone with Lee Lamar's name on it. If you will go home with me I will show it to you.' This gentleman's name is J. B. Mathews. I said: 'I will go with you if you will take me to Manassas in the morning.' 'I will go with you,' said he.

"He then took me and introduced me to his mother and sister who pressed me to go with them to their home. We were soon in their carriage, and with a pair of home-raised Virginia mares, we were speeding down the pike. Soon we reached their home where they said, 'Pull off your coat, make yourself at home and we will go and look at those graves.'

"As we went down to the field Mr. Mathews said: 'My father was living in that house. The Eighth Georgia Regiment was just over the hill. A Federal general came and said: 'We will soon have a fight here and you had better get out.' My father had not left the home long before the battle opened.'

BENEATH THE CEDARS

"The Eighth Georgia Regiment was just resting lying down, arms stacked, so the gentleman said, and were completely surprised and badly cut up. We found the little headstones leaning up against the tree. One was Lee Lamar's and the other was W. G. Allen's. 'Right here are the graves beside this cedar,' said the man.

"The cedar had been cut down and the stone was lying beside the stump. Nothing on the little headstones but the name. No date, no company or regiment. I think Allen was a brother-in-law of Lee Lamar's. There is near the Lamar and Allen graves one other marble block with the name of George Stovall, of the Eighth Georgia Regiment, from Rome, Ga.

"In a few years these headstones will be removed unless friends of the dead do something to protect them. If any of the friends of those I have mentioned would write to J. B. Mathews, Manassas, Va., I think arrangements could be made to do something that line of writing Mrs. Mathews, Alexandria, Va., to assist in the work. I am not closing this letter saying that to J. B. 


