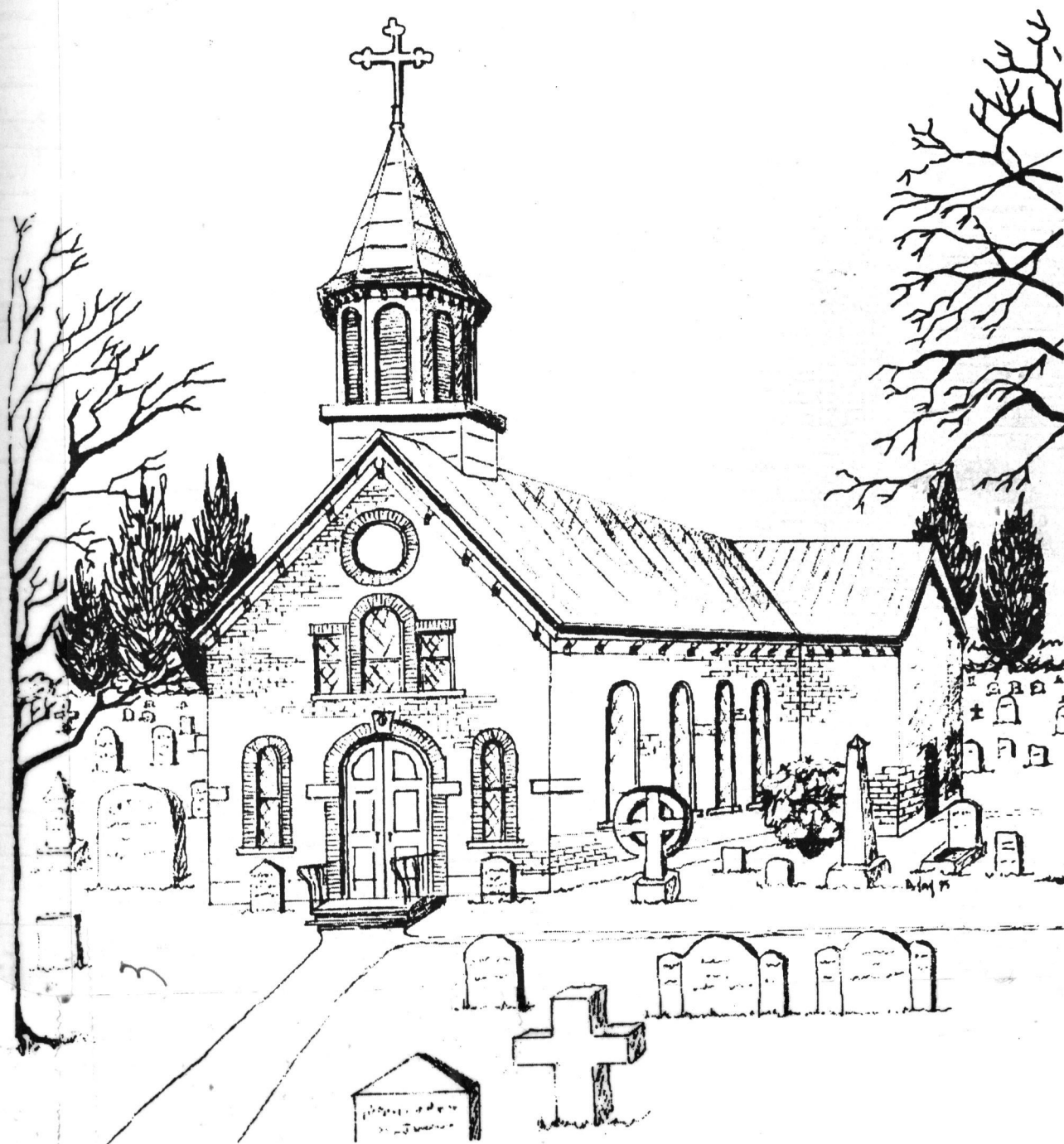

## PREFACE

The principal contents of this book are vital statistics obtained from St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Haymarket, Virginia. The data were extracted from the Parish Records in the Church Registers and, in the case of death records, from tombstone inscriptions in the church cemetery. The church records cover the period from 1837 through 1995. The main body of the book is presented in six sections as follows: Baptisms, Marriages, Deaths (Burials at St. Paul's), Deaths (Cemetery Stones), Deaths (Burials at St. Paul's without Cemetery or Lot Numbers Listed) and Deaths (Burials Elsewhere). The fourth section of the book lists all tombstone inscriptions, some of which were not found in the Parish Registers. In some cases the date of death in the Register does not match the tombstone inscription. When there are inconsistencies in the dates, the reader should look for another source to verify which is correct. The sixth section lists deaths of persons for which funeral services were held at St. Paul's, but interment was elsewhere. In all cases where it was identified, the burial site is given. The reader should note that pagination of the book begins with the first vital records section on Baptisms. This was to facilitate the preparation of an all name index, including surnames and given names, that is found at the end of the book. Note also that all vital records are presented in landscape format to make them more readable. In extracting records from the Parish Registers, every effort was made to ensure that the data has been presented exactly as recorded in the Registers.

The vital records contained herein are solely from St. Paul's Parish Registers and the Cemetery Stones. No research was done to determine whether or not persons originally buried at St. Paul's were subsequently moved to another site. The book committee has learned that some bodies were probably moved. It is also highly probable that there were some baptisms, marriages and deaths handled by the church that, for reasons that are not known, were not recorded. If this be the case, the records are obviously incomplete. Historical information about the church and a list of all ministers are included in the front matter of this book. This material includes a reprint of an article written on the 100th Anniversary of the church. Historical information was extracted from the church publication which celebrated its 150th Anniversary. An Addendum covering the last decade is also included. For convenience, the reader will find a map of the church cemetery showing Lot Numbers and family names at the back of the book. Prior to publication, this book was reviewed and approved by two representatives of St. Paul's Episcopal Church.

## St. Paul's Church, Haymarket, Va.

The history of St. Paul's Church begins with that of Haymarket itself. That village, at first the "Red House," called after its one inn or "Ordinary," was founded in the year of grace 1799. A deed for the site of the District Court House, now St. Paul's Church, was obtained from Mr. Skinker in 1801. Dettingen Parish was created in 1744, Leeds, taken from it 1769. Haymarket was first in Dettingen, then in Leeds, till Haymarket Parish was established about 1833.

St. Paul's, Haymarket, is not only the oldest church in Prince William County, but the most interesting. The walls are the same that were built at the close of the eighteenth century. The District Court House, with its clerks office and jail on the same lot, was used by the legislators of four counties -- Fairfax, Fauquier, Loudoun and Prince William till 1807, when a change in our system of law left it vacant. For a while a school was kept there. In 1830 it was converted into a church, with a square railed-in chancel in the west end, a high pulpit back of this, and underneath this last in front, a small table with marble top used for Holy Communion. Such was the idea of churchly fitness prevailing in those days. What had been the jury room was converted into a vestry and rector's study. This opened into a gallery supported by pillars and was in the east end of the building, so that the clergy had a long march down steps and up the aisle to the chancel.

In Bishop Meade's "Old Churches and Families of Virginia," published in 1831, he says: "A new and excellent store church has been built at Brentsville, in Prince William County, and the old court house at Haymarket has been purchased and converted into a handsome and convenient temple of religion. A race course once adjoined the buildings, and in preaching there in former days I have on a Sabbath seen from the court house bench on which I stood the horses in training for the sport which was at hand. Those times have, I trust, passed away forever."

Haymarket was probably named after the celebrated race course in England. The passage just quoted goes to show that the great Apostle of our Church in Virginia preached at least once from "the court house bench." He consecrated the new church, preached in it again, and confirmed the first class presented in 1848.

The early history of St. Paul's was not exciting. The Rev. Mr. Slaughter preached there, though living at Brentsville, and was appropriately succeeded by the Rev. Mr. Skull. Despite these suggestions as of a battle ground, the time

seems to have been a peaceful lull before the storm which came later. The Rev. John Towles was appointed rector in 1839 and served for many years preceding the War Between the States. He lived on his own farm near Brentsville, but was a devoted pastor at that place and at Haymarket. He resigned early in the war to enter Confederate service. On the memorable Sunday of the first Battle of Bull Run, not many miles away, a young Confederate Army chaplain was holding service in St. Paul's when the mistaken news came that our side had been defeated. Everyone left the church at once, including the preacher. This was the last service till after the war, four years.

After this first Battle of Bull Run, the most dramatic of all Civil War conflicts, word came from Confederate headquarters to remove from the church everything possible that might interfere with its being used as a hospital. This order was speedily obeyed. The building was soon full of wounded men; and the women of the village and its neighborhood, as usual, did their part. They tore their household linen into bandages and dressings; brought soups, jellies and other nourishment, and helped in every way possible. Large bundles of bed-clothes and other things were sent in from the surrounding country. The extent of this work may be guessed from the sad fact that eighty soldiers of the Confederacy passed away within the walls of St. Paul's Church, and were buried in the churchyard and an adjoining lot. Some of these bodies were later removed. Several officers were buried in the churchyard, but only two were permanently left. It is a matter of regret that the graves were not all marked; but in the stress of the terrible years which followed this is not to be wondered at.

After the second Battle of Bull Run (or Manassas) the church was again used as a hospital, this time by the Federals, and left with only the walls standing. Pews and pulpit had been used for firewood. Windows and doors were gone. It is said that horses were stabled there at times. The "despot's heel" was then indeed on the floor of many a church in Virginia. It must, however, in justice be added that when a claim for damages was afterwards presented it was ultimately paid by the Federal Government.

The church was still in a ruinous condition when the Rev. William Alrich became rector in 1867. Though from Delaware, he had been in the Confederate Army, like most of the younger Virginian clergy of that day. His field of work at Haymarket was not encouraging. The village had been burned, with the exception of four houses, and the whole stretch of surrounding country had been devastated. Not a family, high or low, but had suffered and lost. And as a rule, church people belonged to the slaveholding class that had lost most heavily. Mr. Alrich began at once trying to raise funds. He went North and collected six hundred dollars - a larger sum then than it is now. With this, new pews and other missing things were bought, walls and floors repaired, and with much hard labor on the part of the congregation, the old church was once more made ready for use.



The women of the parish were meanwhile at work. They made money by sewing, knitting, and in other ways, and bought the needed church furniture, a Holy Communion table, two large chairs, and a small lectern of black walnut, hand-carved. The chairs are still in use, and the table has only recently been replaced by an altar. The silver plate for Holy Communion, still in use today, was hidden by one of the vestrymen, Mr. Frederick Foote, in the cellar of his home, "Waverly." The Bible and some other prized articles were secreted by the Misses Gray, who lived near the church, and for many years were its faithful caretakers. One of them, Miss Ellen, was a member of the first confirmation class. Her sister, Miss Sarah, though nominally a Methodist, was often heard to remark, "I reckon I've loved that old church just as well as Ellen has." These two old people were cared for when helpless by the village church members. Dying in 1906, they left their little home to St. Paul's. It was taken down and replaced by a neat and useful parish hall, largely the gift of the late T.N. De Pauw.

In regards to later changes and improvements:

During the rectorship of the Rev. Arthur Powell Gray, some changes were made. The old court house porch, with its flagstone floor and brick pillars connected by arches, was enclosed for a much-needed vestibule, the old gallery was torn down and the former jury and vestry room made into a gallery. A vestry room at the head of the church was added.

In the rectorship of the Rev. Byrd Turner, in 1894, other changes and improvements were made in both church and rectory. Again the ladies of the congregation did their best. A goodly sum was realized from a "chain of giving" conducted by Miss Lucy Fontaine Berkeley. The metal ceiling, which replaced falling plaster, was put in place at this time. A tower was built through the efforts of the late Richard Belches, Esq., and Mr. Enoch Pratt, of Baltimore, gave a bell for it. Mr. Belches also gave and helped to put down a new floor. He was an Englishman, very liberal, and much attached to the church. Many others helped. Mrs. Grayson Tyler, of Buckland, worked for the handsome new pews. New windows, the present ones, were donated by Mrs. Caroline Dulany. The Rev. Byrd Turner worked with his own hands on an addition to the rectory.

The present recess chancel was built while the Rev. George Somerville was rector, about 1897, and is a beautiful addition to the church. The present vestry room also dates from this time. These changes were followed by many gifts. The brass eagle lectern now in use is a memorial to Mr. Somerville, given by the congregation in affectionate and grateful remembrance of his wonderful ministry, under which the church experienced its greatest religious revival.

No later changes of importance have been made in the church. The present rectory was built for the Rev. Mr. Kloman and added to by the Rev. Cary Gamble. Many improvements were made by the Rev. and Mrs. Thomas Moore

Browne. The parish house was built while the Rev. Andrew Grinnan was with us, one of St. Paul's most devoted pastors.

A few more facts, some amusing, in connection with St. Paul's:

When the church was first opened after the War Between the States, it was heated by an enormous stove, and the vestrymen took turns in making the fire for Sunday morning services. It was said that the further away the vestryman lived the better his fire; which goes to show the truth of the old saying, "Where there's a will," and so forth. The Sunday school was often kept up by women alone when there was no rector. In its early days there were two maiden ladies the Misses Sallie and Louise Tyler, of "Woodlawn," who were especially active in this work. Peace to their gentle shades! For many years of late date Miss Susan Monroe was a familiar figure, riding up every Sunday morning on her white horse, "Surry," to take whatever part in the Sunday school she was most needed for, whether superintendent, teacher, or both. "Miss Sue," as she was called, lived on the Bull Run Battlefield, dividing her time between church work and the collection of Confederate relics. Her horse was doubtless named after John Esten Cooke's famous military hero, "Surry of Eagle's Nest." When he died of old age friends in the church gave Miss Sue another horse, and her Sunday school work ended only when failing health made its continuance impossible. She passed away in 1919 faithful to the last.

It is to be regretted that often, in the course of changes, and even of needed improvements, some of the most interesting things are set aside. This was the case with the two old tablets, containing in plain black letters the Lord's Prayer and the Ten Commandments, that were placed, one on either side of the chancel at St. Paul's. They are still in existence as valued relics, but these days of increasing impiety and lawlessness it seems a great pity that they should not be replaced on the wall of the church. Many a child of former days has spelled them over in sermon-time, and afterward remembered. It should be borne in mind that in a Temple of Religion no added conveniences or beauties can make up for the loss of things so directly characteristic of the faith.

The more perishable little black velvet bags once used in collection, each at the end of a long stick handle, gave a touch of quaintness which appealed to at least one child many years ago.

The music at St. Paul's is good, and rendered by a vested choir. The churchyard is most attractive and well kept. Here, one finds on monuments and headstones most of the surnames connected with the church since its beginning. Here lie Tylers, Berkeleys, Carters, Footes, Bleights, Meades, Jordans and many others too numerous to mention. The graves of several Confederate veterans add interest to the spot and to Decoration Day services.

## **The Story of St. Paul's Church**

The building which is now St. Paul's Episcopal Church, Haymarket, was originally the District Court House for the Counties of Fairfax, Fauquier, Loudoun, and Prince William. The deed is dated September 4, 1801. It was designed by James Wren (an area resident and a distant relative of Sir Christopher Wren), who is also credited with the design of Christ Church, Alexandria, and the Fairfax County Court House. Haymarket Masonic Lodge No. 62 was organized in December 1802 and their meetings were held in the gallery of this Court House. The first Court was held in this building in the spring of 1803. In 1807 the General Assembly created the Circuit Courts for each county. The last District Court at Haymarket was held in this building October to November 3, 1808. The first Circuit Court thereafter was held in Dumfries, May 15, 1809. The General Assembly ordered the Court House in Haymarket to be sold January 30, 1812. It was bought by the Hygeia Academy, which was incorporated in 1814, but closed its doors in 1816, sinking under a load of debt.

Sale of property was not made until 1822, when it was purchased by William Skinker, Jr., who had inherited Green Hill Plantation from his father in 1752 and had laid out the town of Haymarket in 1798, naming it for the famous race course in London.

In 1822, the Reverend "Parson Steele," a Methodist minister who had become an Episcopal minister, came to Haymarket, held services in the old Court House, and labored earnestly for eight years organizing an Episcopal congregation. During this time the old Court House was also used as a school, for various public meetings, and for church services by various denominations, one of which we know was the Presbyterians.

In 1830, William Skinker deeded the old Court House to the Episcopal Church in memory of his wife Harriet Keith Skinker, with one-and-one-half acres of ground.

Bishop William Meade made the following report on his visit to Haymarket on October 12 and 13, 1833:

"On Friday, the 11th of October, I left home and preached that day at Upperville. Saturday and Sunday I spent at Haymarket. The weather was so inclement and the house so open, that the congregation on the first day was small. On the day following the Lord's day, the weather was good, and the congregation was large and attentive. The house in which I preached was an old deserted courthouse, which, nevertheless, was capable of being converted

into a comfortable church, at a very moderate expense. At the conclusion of the services I addressed them on the condition of the neighborhood and the house in which we were assembled, and promised that if they would convert the house into a becoming place of worship, I would visit them again in the month of July, and dedicate it to God, and perform all the holy ordinances of the church in it. As I came down from the pulpit, two gentlemen assured me it should be done; and I am happy to learn that their promise has already been sacredly fulfilled. If God spare my life I will endeavor to fulfill my part, and hope that some of my brethren will be there to aid in the good work."

The following report was made by Bishop William Meade to the Convention at Lynchburg in 1835 concerning events of 1834:

"I then returned home, and after spending a few weeks there, set out in a short visitation to Prince William County. I was much gratified in being able to set apart to the exclusive worship of Almighty God a most excellent building at Haymarket, which was originally a courthouse, and had been, without alteration, used for many years for religious meetings. It has been recently secured by the friends of the church, and very neatly and comfortably fitted up for public worship. In this place I was engaged, together with the Rev. Mr. Adie, in the performance of religious services during the 8th, 9th, and 10th of August. Our meetings were long and interesting, and calculated to encourage our hopes that good was done. The sacrament was administered, and thirteen persons confirmed. In the afternoon of the Sabbath, as on another occasion at a private house, I preached to the coloured persons, who appeared attentive and thankful. On the two following days we were engaged in similar services at Brentsville, where four persons were confirmed. The two places afford a fine field of labour to a minister of the gospel; the Rev. Mr. Slaughter is now employed in it."

The church was used as a Confederate Hospital after the First Battle of Manassas, July 21, 1861. Eighty soldiers died and were buried in a long trench along the south side of the churchyard. After the Battle of Gainesville, 1862, the Northern wounded were taken to St. Paul's and those who died were buried in a trench along the extreme west of the churchyard. Later the 11th Alabama Infantry used St. Paul's as a hospital and buried their dead on the south side of the churchyard.

When the Northern troops burned Haymarket, November 5, 1862, St. Paul's was spared, but was later used as a stable for Northern cavalry horses. Before they left, the Federal troops set fire to the building, which was left with only the walls standing.

Rev. William A. Alrich became rector of St. Paul's on March 1, 1867. Going north among his friends, he raised \$600 for the purpose of repairing the church;

the first service in the renovated church was held September 1, 1867, from which time to the present it has been in use as an Episcopal Church.

In 1974, for the first time since the Civil War, St. Paul's Church was closed. It was discovered that the foundations at each end and falling plaster made the building actually unsafe. The nave itself, the original building which had survived war and fire, was sound but the foundations of later additions - the chancel at one end and narthex or vestibule at the other - might collapse. Estimates as high as \$100,000 for complete restoration startled the congregation.

The vestry decided that as much of the work as possible should be done by the men of the parish. The first workday, organized by Macon Piercy, Senior Warden and Chairman of the restoration, was held February 22, 1975. Twenty-one men came to offer their services that day including several not affiliated with St. Paul's. They brought tools, trucks and tractors. The ladies came to prepare the lunch.

In that long workday (9:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.) the foundations under the chancel and sanctuary were reinforced; the unsafe wooden floor in the narthex was replaced by filling in the space below with gravel and concrete to be surfaced with brick; and everything was removed from the chancel in preparation for the dry wall men who were to resurface the entire chancel area where old plaster had been falling. The Lord provided the skills that were needed for this workday, including a subway tunnel man to work on shoring up the chancel. It was estimated that \$9,000 worth of repairs were accomplished.

Other restoration work was done by professionals. There were many gifts of building materials and money to help in the restoration. The ladies of the parish spent many hours cleaning the church after the dry wall sanding and other repairs were completed.

After holding services in the Parish Hall for eight months, the congregation joyfully and thankfully marched in procession back to the church for the 1975 Easter Sunday service. However, the work was not yet completed on that Easter Sunday - the steeple was still being repaired. The 20-foot timbers supporting the steeple were rotted at the bottom - wormeaten. While repairs were being made to it, a scaffolding broke under a carpenter working on the outside of the steeple. He was saved by the handle of a saw in his hand catching on a lightning arrester wire. Church members and the vestry had been praying for the work, and for the protection of the workers.

In 1984, the old radiators were removed from the church and a new heating and air conditioning system installed.



St. Paul's Church, the oldest church of Prince William County, is now on the National Register of Historical Places, as well as the registers of Virginia and Prince William County.

### **Addendum**

At the present time, St. Paul's has, in addition to its weekly Sunday worship services, a Sunday School for all ages, including an excellent adult class; Vacation Bible School each summer; and committees taking responsibility under the vestry for each facet of parish life.

Several young people have gone from St. Paul's to serve as missionaries in other countries. The first parish member, so far as known, to go into the ordained ministry is the Rev. C. Thomas Hayes, ordained in 1983. Many seminarians from Virginia Theological Seminary have trained at St. Paul's; gaining experience in parish ministry. They are all remembered with great affection by the parishioners.

A valuable parish resource is St. Paul's Library, which began with a few books entered on November 1, 1969 - gifts of several people from their own collections. As a result of the late Jacquelin Smith's dedication to this project, it has grown from a bookcase in one corner of the main room of the Parish Hall to its own room with shelves holding some 1700 books.

After more than 160 years, St. Paul's continues to be a place of worship, ministry and love.

## EXPLANATIONS

As stated in the PREFACE, the following records of births, marriages and deaths include all entries to be found in the parish registers and in the cemetery inscriptions at St. Paul's Church. The original plan was only to read, record and publish all tombstone inscriptions. When the book committee learned of the existence of the valuable parish records, the project was expanded to its present form. All original entries were made in the parish registers by hand. In the extraction of the records, the original spelling of names as they were entered is always followed. With these records there is the possibility of errors in the spelling of names either because of an incorrect entry by the person recording the data or by the extractors in their interpretation of the handwriting. Therefore the readers should examine all possible ways that the names could be spelled as they use the alphabetical index in the back section of the book. With the hope that there are none, the book committee apologizes for any incorrect spelling of names that could have been avoided.
