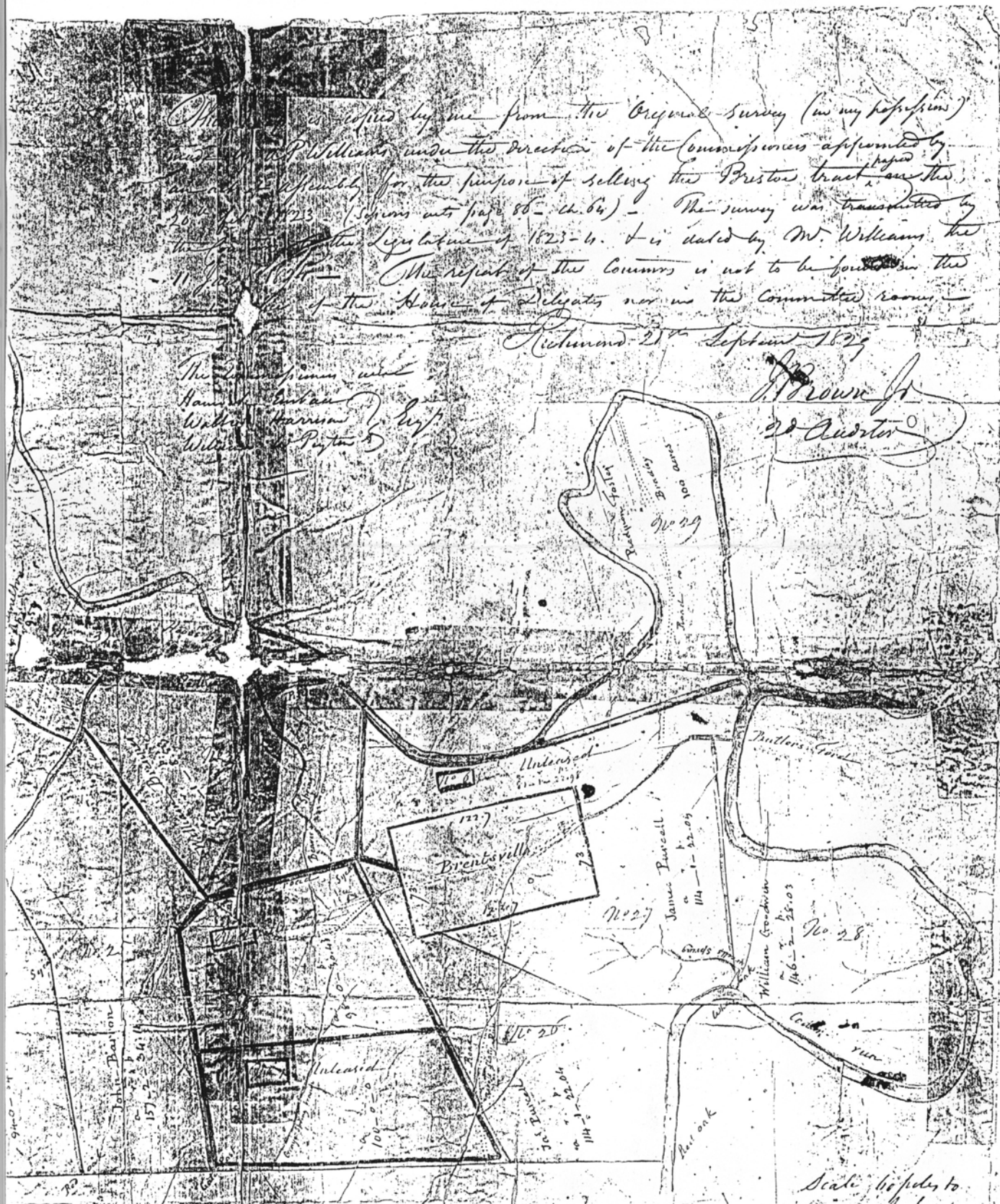


This is copied by me from the Original Survey (in my possession)

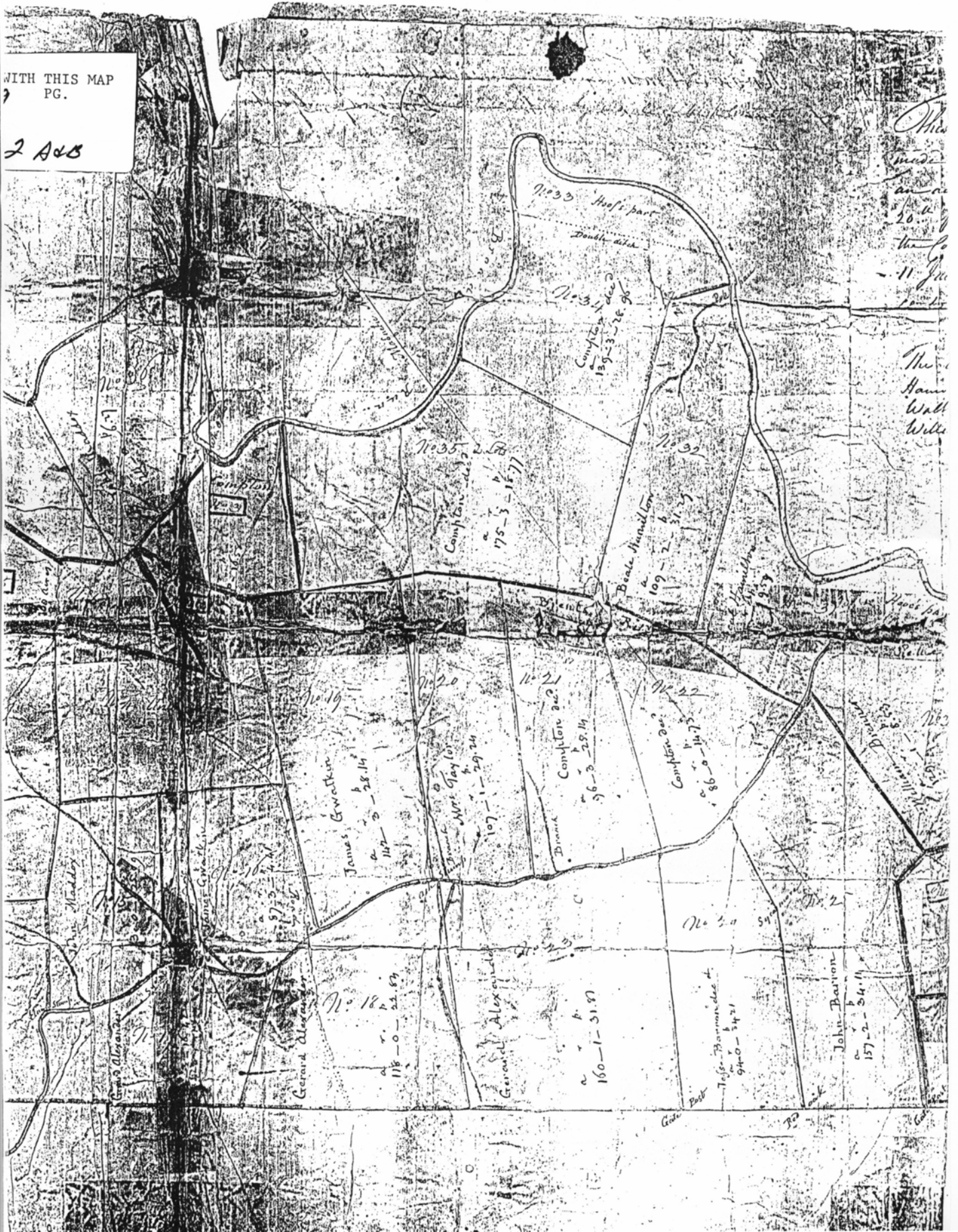
