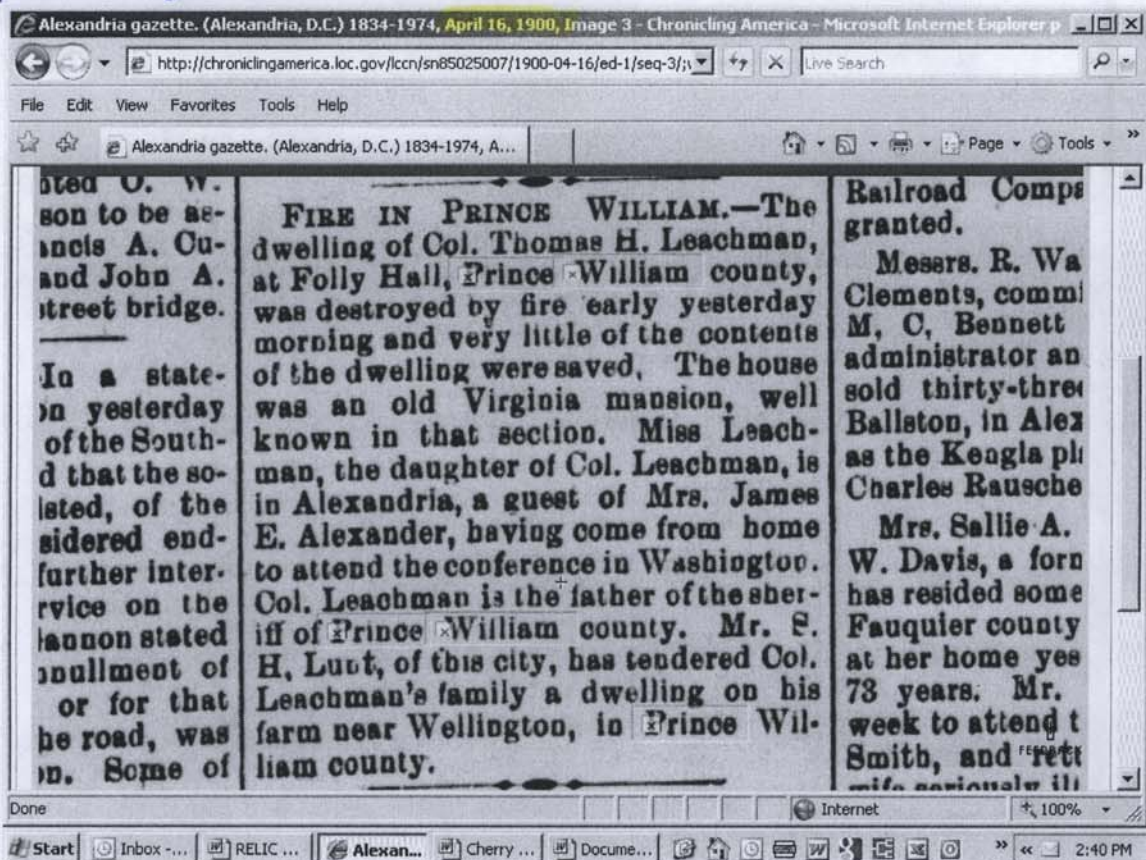


The following sheets have information on the French artist, **Louis (or Leopold) KOWALSKY**. In 1885 he stayed at *Brownsville* for about 6 months while he painted the renowned "Panorama of the Second Battle of Bull Run." Kowalsky also painted the picture of *Brownsville* which appears in R. J. Ratcliffe's book "This Was Prince William," p.121. Engravings exist of the famous panorama; and the original painting was on view for many years in a building located at 15th and Ohio Streets, in Washington, D.C., but the present whereabouts of the painting are unknown.
