RICHMOND (AP) -Godwin Jr. and a host of federal and state officials and oil company executives today went into a high-level conference to discuss Virginia's burgeoning gasoline crisis.

At the outset of the meeting, Godwin asked the press if they would be so kind as to "excuse us for a while.

Shortly before 10 o'clock, Godwin, accompanied by Atty. Gen. Andrew Miller, Secretary of Administration Maurice Rowe and other state officials emerged, without comment, and headed for the large-scale meeting.

The shortage reportedly has reached crisis proportions in Tidewater, where drivers Thursday found lines stretching for miles from those gasoline pumps still operating.

An estimated 20 to 30 per cent of the area's gasoline stations have already closed due to a lack of gasoline, and other operators predicted a 98-per cent effective strike through Tuesday.
