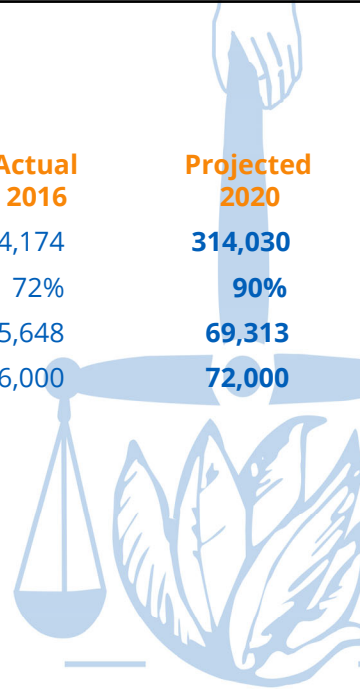
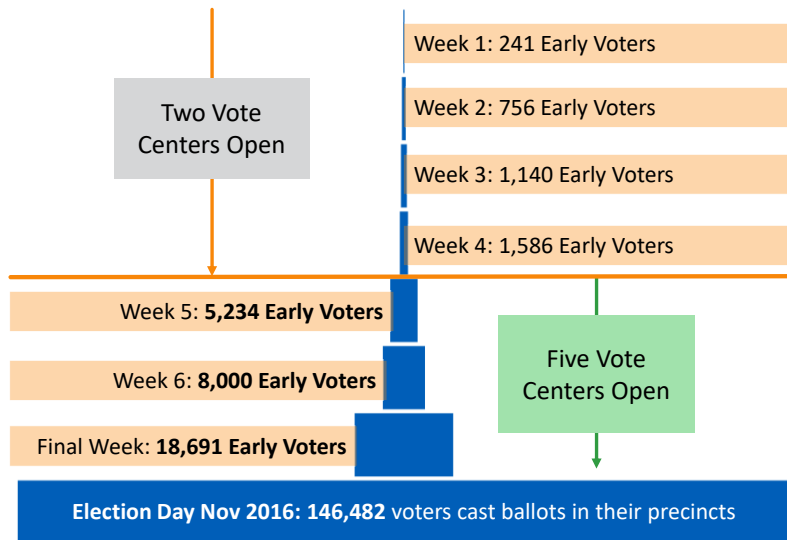


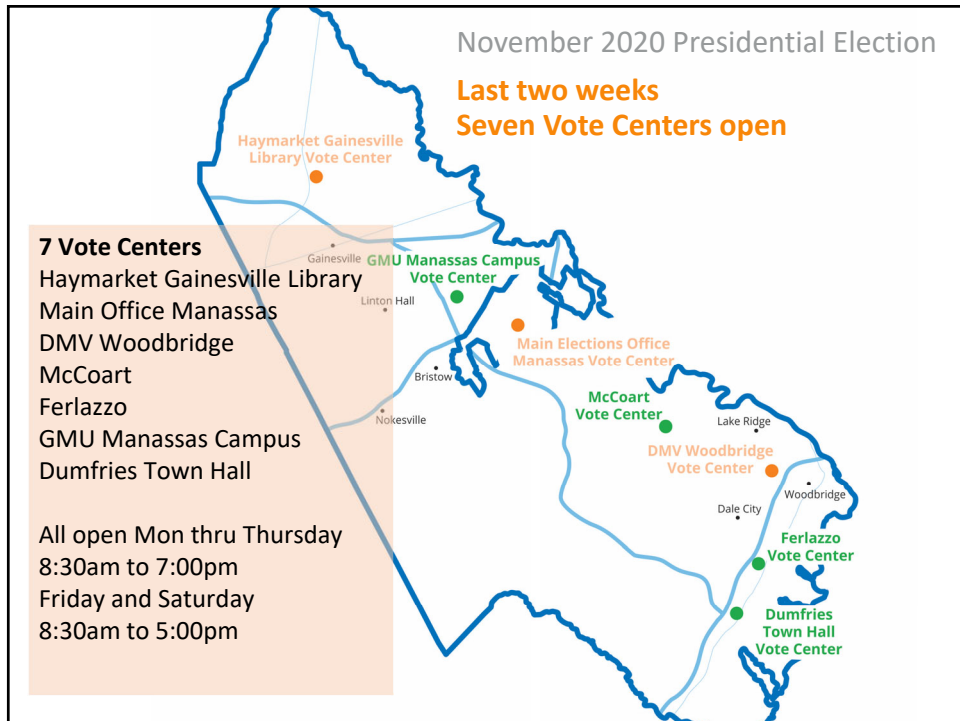
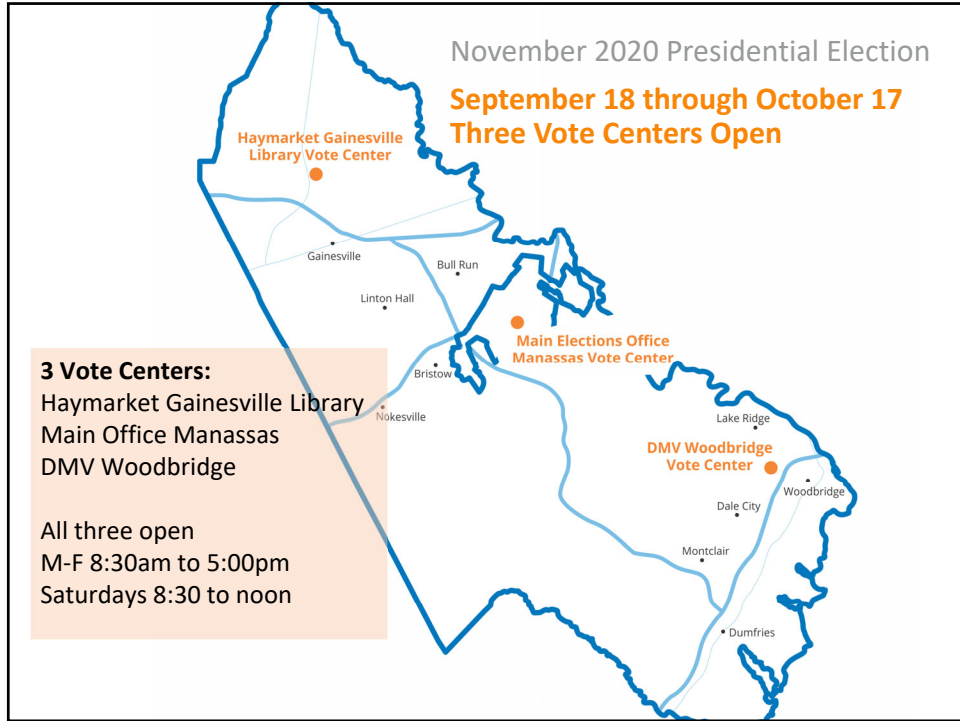

Things the Voting Public Should Know about Voting by Mail

Deadline to request your mail ballot is Friday October 23

Online Requests for November mail ballots are being accepted now at www.elections.virginia.gov

If you prefer a paper request for a ballot, please call the Office of Elections at 703-792-6470 and press "0"

Ballots will not be mailed until mid September

If you do not get your ballot in a timely fashion call the Office of Elections ASAP. We can fix problems if we are aware of them.

- Text messaging

- PSAs through County Communications
