ACTION:

WHEREAS, conveyance of the proposed sanitary sewer easement to the Prince William County Service Authority (PWCSA) over County-owned property located at 8324 Bethlehem Road is needed to connect the existing 15" sanitary sewer pipes to provide sanitary sewer service to the adjoining parcel; and

WHEREAS, installation of a sanitary sewer pipe over the County-owned property located at 8324 Bethlehem Road, at no public cost, will improve the sanitary sewer system and provide opportunities for possible future connections along Prince William Parkway, in addition to meeting the PWCSA's vision in providing clean water, public sewer, and excellent customer service through sustainable business practices and community partnership; and

WHEREAS, construction of the sewer pipe requires a twenty-five-foot-wide sanitary sewer easement to the PWCSA over County-owned property located 8324 Bethlehem Road; and

WHEREAS, PWCSA has requested the twenty-five-foot-wide sanitary sewer easement; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing has been held prior to conveyance of the easements as authorized by Section 15.2-1800(B), VA Code Ann.; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was authorized March 16, 2021, via Resolution Number (Res No.) 21-161, and has been duly advertised for this purpose and was conducted on May 4, 2021, pursuant to Section 15.2-1800(B) and Section 15.2-1813 Va. Code annotated for this purpose and all interested citizens were heard; and

WHEREAS, County staff recommends authorizing conveyance of a twenty-five-footwide sanitary sewer easement to the PWCSA over County-owned property located 8324 Bethlehem Road; and

WHEREAS, the Prince William Board of County Supervisors finds that conveyance of the easement secures and promotes the health, safety, and general welfare of the County and its residents;

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Prince William Board of County Supervisors hereby authorizes conveyance of a twenty-five-foot-wide sanitary sewer easement to the PWCSA over County-owned property located 8324 Bethlehem Road in the Brentsville Magisterial District Project as set forth in the attachment;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Prince William Board of County Supervisors hereby authorizes the Director of Transportation, or his designee, to execute such documents that are necessary, and/or appropriate, to affect the intent of this resolution and are approved as to form by the County Attorney's Office.



EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The proposed conveyance of a sanitary sewer easement to the Prince William County Service Authority (PWCSA) over County-owned property located at 8324 Bethlehem Road is needed to connect the existing 15" sanitary sewer pipes to provide sanitary sewer service to the adjoining Lucky Seven Manassas, Inc., owned parcel. This includes construction of a sanitary sewer pipe on the County-owned parcel, at no public cost. This will improve the sanitary sewer system and provide opportunities for possible future connections along Prince William Parkway, in addition to meeting the PWCSA's vision in providing clean water, public sewer, and excellent customer service through sustainable business practices and community partnership.

It is the recommendation of County staff that the Prince William Board of County Supervisors (Board) authorize conveyance of a twenty-five-foot-wide sanitary sewer easement to the Prince William County Service Authority over County-owned property located at 8324 Bethlehem Road.

BACKGROUND

The intent of the proposed sanitary sewer easement on the County-owned property located at 8324 Bethlehem Road is to connect the existing 15" sanitary sewer pipes to provide sanitary sewer service to the adjoining parcel Lucky Seven Manassas, Inc. This includes construction of a sanitary sewer pipe on the County-owned parcel, at no public cost. This will improve the sanitary sewer system and provide opportunities for possible future connections along Prince William Parkway, in addition to meeting the PWCSA's vision in providing clean water, public sewer, and excellent customer service through sustainable business practices and community partnership.

The PWCSA has requested the easement and the District Supervisor will be notified, via email, of the request to authorize conveyance of the easement.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

It is the recommendation of County staff that the Board authorize conveyance of a twenty-five-foot-wide sanitary sewer easement to the PWCSA over County-owned property located at 8324 Bethlehem Road in the Brentsville Magisterial District.

Service Level / Policy Impact

Completion of the Project will enhance and improve PWCSA's ability to promote the health, safety, and general welfare of the County and its residents by enhancing and improving water and sewer services.

Fiscal Impact

No costs will be incurred by the County and the easement will be maintained by PWCSA.

Legal Impact




