RE: REQUEST THE COMMONWEALTH TRANSPORTATION BOARD TO RESTRICT THROUGH-TRUCK TRAFFIC ON SANDERS LANE, ROUTE 705 – GAINESVILLE MAGISTERIAL DISTRICT

ACTION: APPROVED

WHEREAS, Sanders Lane is not designed or intended to serve heavy truck traffic; and

WHEREAS, Sanders Lane is not recommended for trucks due to the roadway design; and

WHEREAS, heavy truck traffic causes safety problems on Sanders Lane; and

WHEREAS, an alternative route exists via Sudley Road, Route 234 to Gum Spring Road, Route 659 to Braddock Road, Route 620 in Loudoun County to Lightridge Farm Road, Route 705 in Loudoun County to Sanders Lane, Route 705 at the Prince William County Line; and

WHEREAS, the alternate route is depicted on the attached map; and

WHEREAS, Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) Traffic Engineering has reviewed the proposed alternate route and is in agreement; and

WHEREAS, Section 46.2-809 of the Code of Virginia mandates that a public hearing must be held by the local governing body to receive public comments on restricting through-truck traffic on any part of a secondary highway; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 13-320.1 of the Prince William County Code, a public meeting was authorized by the Board of County Supervisors on January 21, 2013, by Resolution No. 14-33, and held on March 11, 2014 to obtain public comments on requesting the Commonwealth Transportation Board to restrict through-truck traffic; and

WHEREAS, the Prince William County Police Department will be responsible for enforcing the restriction;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Prince William Board of County Supervisors does hereby request the Commonwealth Transportation Board to restrict through-truck traffic on Sanders Lane, Route 705, in the Gainesville Magisterial District;

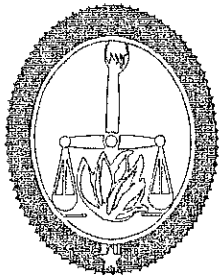
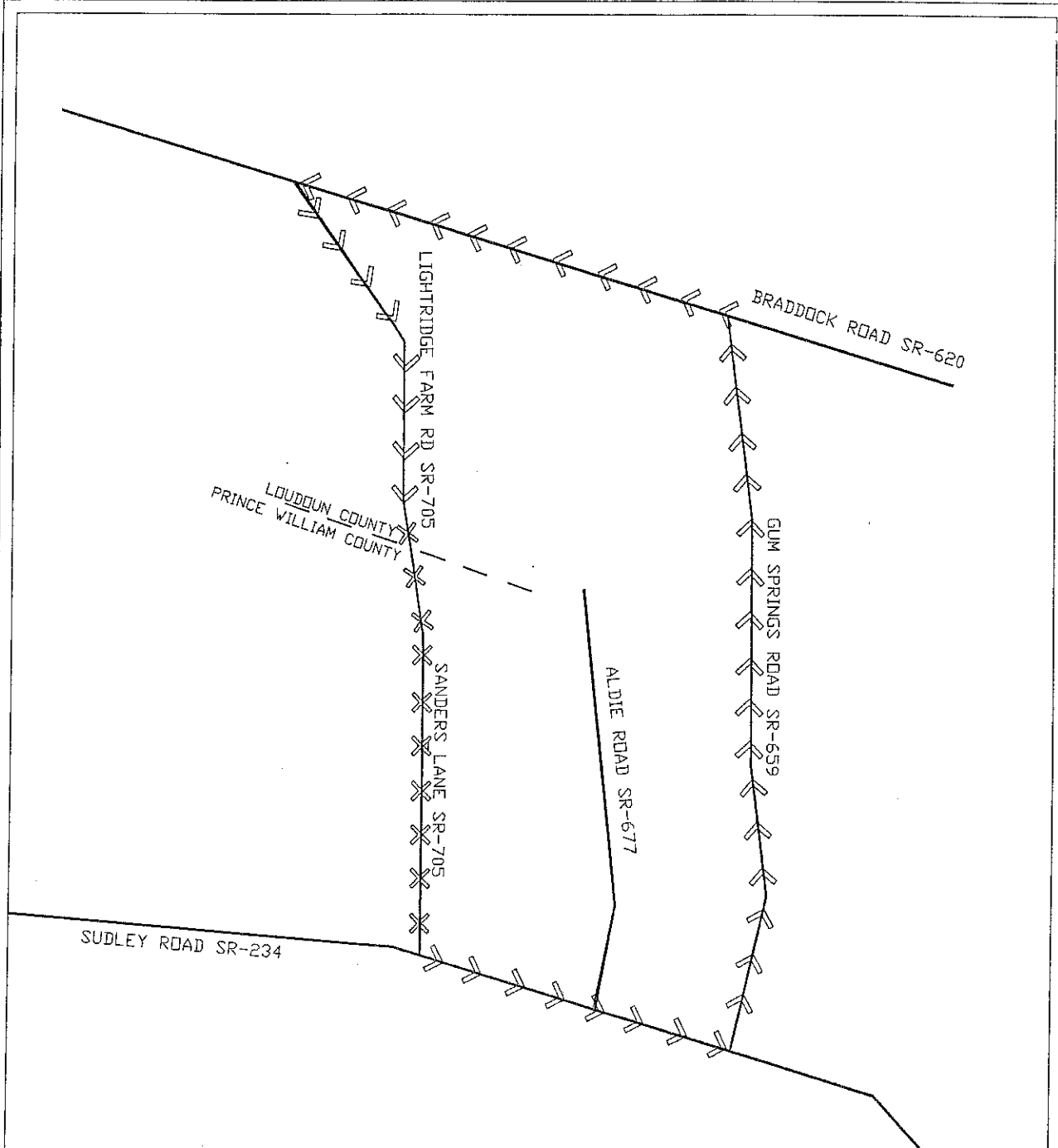

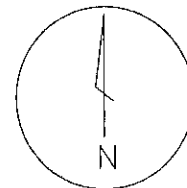
