**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Prince William Board of County Supervisors hereby directs the County Executive to advertise a public hearing to be held on April 30, 2019 at 7:30 p.m. in the Board Chambers at the McCoart Government Building for the purpose of increasing the tangible personal property taxation rate for the programmable computer equipment and peripherals employed in a trade or business from the current rate of \$1.25 per \$100 value to \$2.00 per \$100 value.
