FREE COAL STOCK WENT TO CENTRAL

No Employee or Officer of Road Ever Had Any.

A. J. CASSATT WAS NOT CALLED

Philadelphia, June 5. Contrary to expectations, President Cassatt of the Pennsylvania railroad, did not appear before the interstate commerce commission when it resumed its investigation of the alleged connection of the railroad with the soft coal and oil interests. Commissioner Clements said the investigation had not reached the stage that demanded the testimony of Mr. Cassatt, and he was unable to say whether his appearance would be required by the commission.

The New York Central railroad, the Buffalo, Rochester & Pittsburgh railroad and the Baltimore & Ohio railroad were under investigation, the hearings being conducted by Commissioners Clement and Coakrell.

It developed that no employee or official of the New York Central held stock in coal mining or oil companies. Vice President E. V. W. Roster testified, however, that the Beach Creek Coal and Oil company had presented the railroad with 5000 shares of stock, par value \$100, "for traffic reasons."

Later, when the Beach Creek company was merged into the Pennsylvania Coal and Coke company, this stock was surrendered, the company receiving \$1,500,000 worth of stock in the latter company.

John Kerr, of Clearfield, a coal operator, was asked concerning a reported agreement regarding the placing of sidings which had been made by President Cassatt and the former president of the New York Central. Mr. Kerr could throw no light on the subject. Mr. Kerr said that all his long experience in the Clearfield-Salt Creek district had later known an officer or employee of the New York Central to own a small coal mine share.

John Christopher, vice president of the New York Central, said that he was in charge of the accounting department of the New York Central. He said that he never had personal knowledge of rebates given, but explained that rebates might have been given in various ways, "intention or mistake" and "refunds on errors." When controller of the company he accepted vouchers for what they reported to have been what was vouchered by the proper officers.

"Are you sure that rebates are not given now?" asked Commissioner Clements.

"I am sure that there are not," Christopher responded to the witness.

The above proceedings brought out no revelations of a sensational character.

UNMasks FILTHY MEAT-PACKING

President Sends Report of Investigators to Congress.

DRAMATIC LEGISLATION NEEDED.

Washington, June 5. President Cassatt transmitted to congress the report of the investigation into the meat-packing industry in Chicago, which he had just received from the committee appointed to investigate the conditions at the Chicago stock yards.

The report was accompanied by a message in which the president urged the adoption of the Beveridge amendment, providing for rigid inspection of all meat and meat products entering into interstate commerce and for prescriptive sanitary conditions of the abattoirs.

The president calls attention to the resulting conditions in the stock yards, as shown in the report, and declares that it is imperatively necessary in the interest of health and decency that they be changed. He points out that the existing laws are entirely inadequate and that legislation is not only required to check the abuses found to exist, but to prevent the possibility of further disregard for health by the packers.

He suggests that the cost of inspection be paid by a fee levied on each animal slaughtered, and argues that the present inspection system is a tax not exceeding eight cents per animal. Attention of congress is also called to the improper use of chemicals in preparing meat for market.

The message is accompanied by the fact that the report transmitted is but a preliminary one, and that the doctoring of tainted meat and the preparation of products sent to the packers are as unsalable have not been referred to.

The president then recommends that a law which will enable the inspectors to take possession of the meat from the hoof to the case.

The enactment of a law which will enable the department of agriculture to inspect the meat packing houses and to prescribe sanitary conditions under which the work shall be performed.

The favorable consideration of the Beveridge amendment is recommended.
