Robt. Porter's Will.

The will of the late Robt. Porter, who died at his country home here, has been probated in Washington. Aside from personal bequests, including \$5,000 to Manassah Lodge of Masons to build a Masonic hall, \$5,000 to improve the cemetery of Manassah and 50 shares of National Bank stock, the testator left the income from which is to aid the poor of Manassah, all the estate, exclusive of the brewery at Alexandria, is left in trust to the executor, the American Security and Trust Company, for the benefit of the family of the deceased. His interests in the brewery at Alexandria are divided equally between the ten children, and the American Security and Trust Company is named as trustee of the children who have not attained the age of twenty-five years and also the guardian of the minor children. The estate will exceed three million dollars.





CASSATT GOT NO PRESENTS

President of Pennsylvania R. R. Answers Questions of Probe.

PHILADELPHIA, June 11.—The special committee appointed by the directors of the Pennsylvania Railroad company to investigate the charges of discrimination and rebating recently made against the company pronounced a series of questions to President A. J. Cassatt.
