### Robt. Porter's Will

The will of the late Robt. Porter, who died at his country home here, has been probated in Washington. Aside from personal bequests, including \$5,000 to Manassah Lodge of Masons to build a Masonic hall, \$5,000 to improve the streets of Manassah and 50 shares of National Bank stock, the testator left the income from which is to aid the poor of Manassah, all the estate, exclusive of the brewery at Alexandria, is left in trust to the executor, the American Security and Trust Company, for the benefit of the family of the deceased. His interests in the brewery at Alexandria are divided equally between the ten children, and the American Security and Trust Company is named as trustee of the children who have not attained the age of twenty-five years and also the guardian of the minor children. The estate will exceed three million dollars.

AN AUDITORIUM NEEDED

MR. EDITOR: Manassah needs a spacious and safe auditorium or opera house capable of holding 1,500 or 2,000 people. We are likely to have in the future as in the past a surplus of small audience rooms capable of holding from 300 to 500 people, whose safety may be questionable in case of crowds or panics or accidents. The location of our town and its historic setting is such that it is comparatively easy to gather a crowd of people, but it has not been so easy to give them that entertainment, care and protection from discomforting things that will recommend them to come again.

The magnificent gift from Mr. Porter of \$5,000 makes it possible for the Manassah Lodge to erect a large and beautiful temple that would be a great attraction for our town and an honor to the Masonic Order. To expend this money in erecting business houses and offices, to simply a source of money income to the lodge and to compete with other business houses and renters, would be as it seems, an absurd and unwise thing to do. The object of masonry is the money getting but the development of high principles and public benefits.

It might as well be stated here that our public halls heretofore have neither been creditable or safe. It is easy to imagine how an earthquake or a cyclone or a fire or even such a small thing as the explosion of a lamp or the cry of a child or the shriek of a nervous person or a dozen of other possible things might start a panic which might result in great loss of life and property. An effort ought to be made on a second or third floor and none at all except with a great number of exits.

Such an auditorium should not be located in the business part of town or on any narrow street where abundant room for horses and carriages will not be had. The constant increase of the number and noise of shifting trains on our railroad is another important consideration in deciding on the proper location.

We need a place where all the public can see the most successful calisthenic drills of the Manassah Institute. We need a place for commencement exercises of the schools which are now here and which will hereafter be here for such gatherings as the Meeting of the Society of the Army of the Potomac, the reception of the Georgia Veterans for the exercises of Memorial Days for large political and religious and educational meetings and conventions of all kinds. No private person or partnership is likely to provide this great convenience for the Manassah community. The Manassah Lodge can do it and ought to do it.





## CASSATT GOT NO PRESENTS

PHILADELPHIA, June 11.—The special committee appointed by the directors of the Pennsylvania Railroad company to investigate the charges of discrimination and rebating recently made against the company pronounced a series of questions to President A. J. Cassatt.
