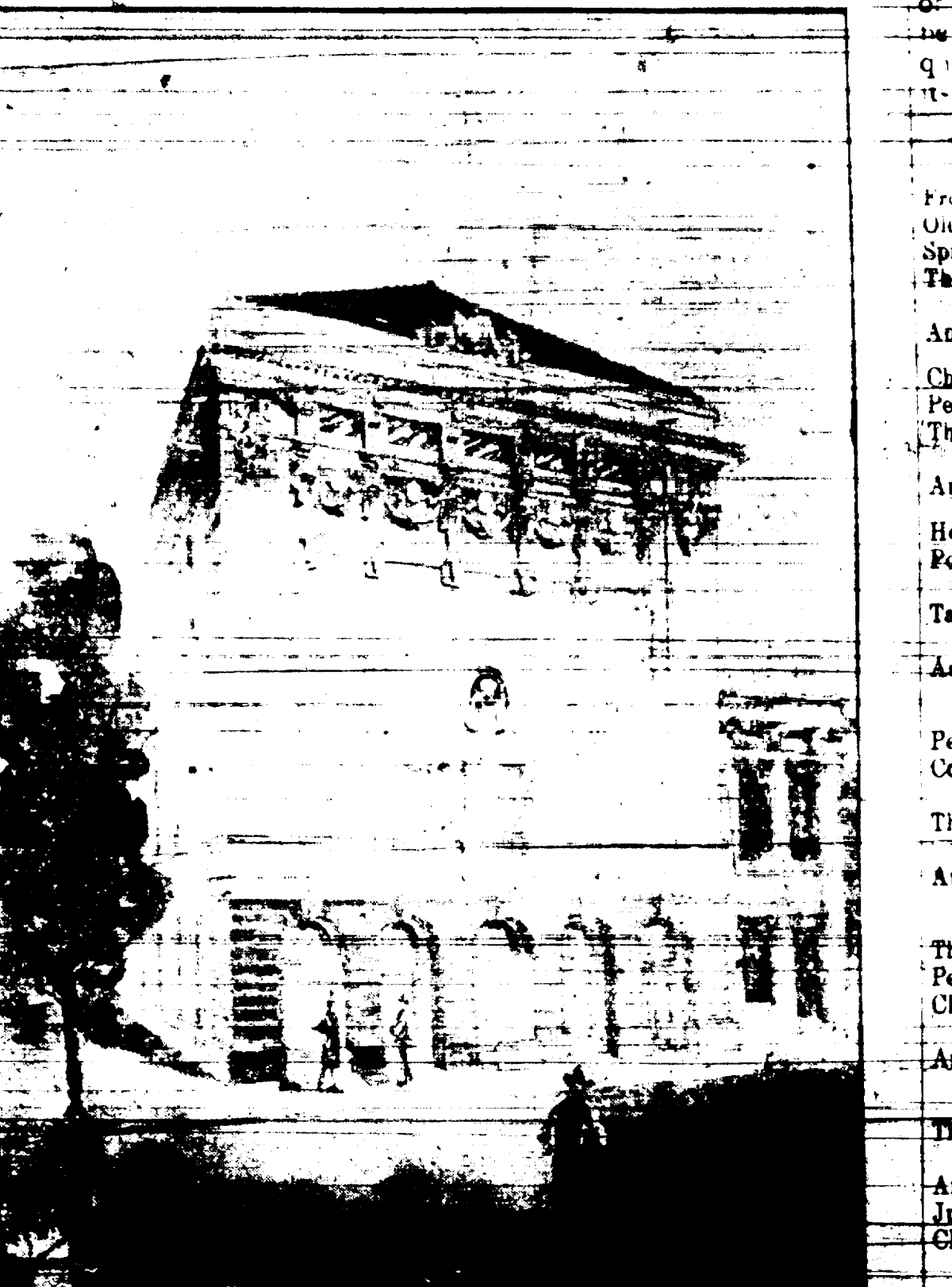

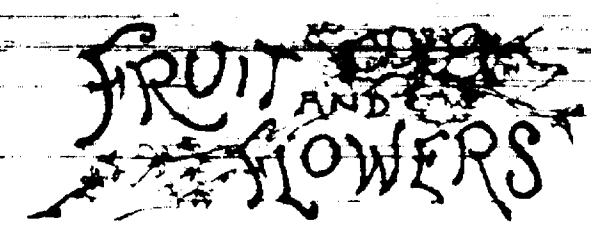

## FRUIT AND FLOWERS

### SPRAYING DORMANT WOOD.

Timely and practical information for the home gardener. It is nearly twenty years ago since I first proved the efficacy of spraying dormant fruit trees with a solution of copper sulphate. The practice has since become a general practice. I recommend it to all gardeners. The most effective in their case, and I prefer to use rather strong solutions. If I were to use iron instead of copper sulphate I would make the solution nearly concentrated. At least we may use a pound to one or two gallons of water without danger to the vines and with greater chances of success than can be expected from weaker solutions. A pound of copper sulphate dissolved in enough for four or five gallons of water. The application should be thorough and may be made whenever convenient before the leaves start on the vines. GREENHOUSE CONSTRUCTION. It is not only an expert carpenter that a big roof greenhouse would give a straight roof. 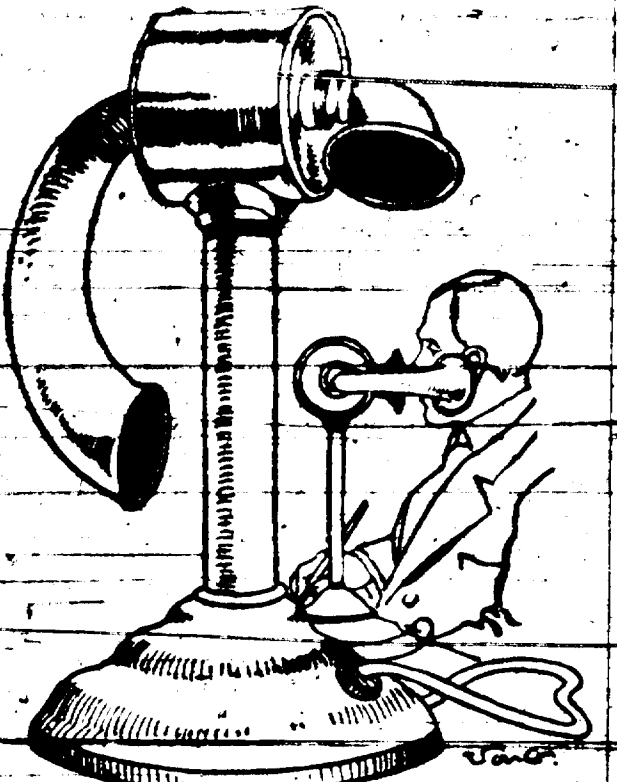

BOULICULTURAL BRIEFINGS. One of the largest growers of gladioli today says it has been his custom to sow the dry bulbs, or corms, the previous year, and to hold them until the first year, even with the best of care, a great many of them dry or rot. In the present day advanced gladiolus culture, Mr. Coffey says he produces many flowers from these small corms the first year and the second year, blooming possibly 50 per cent of the bulbs so treated.
