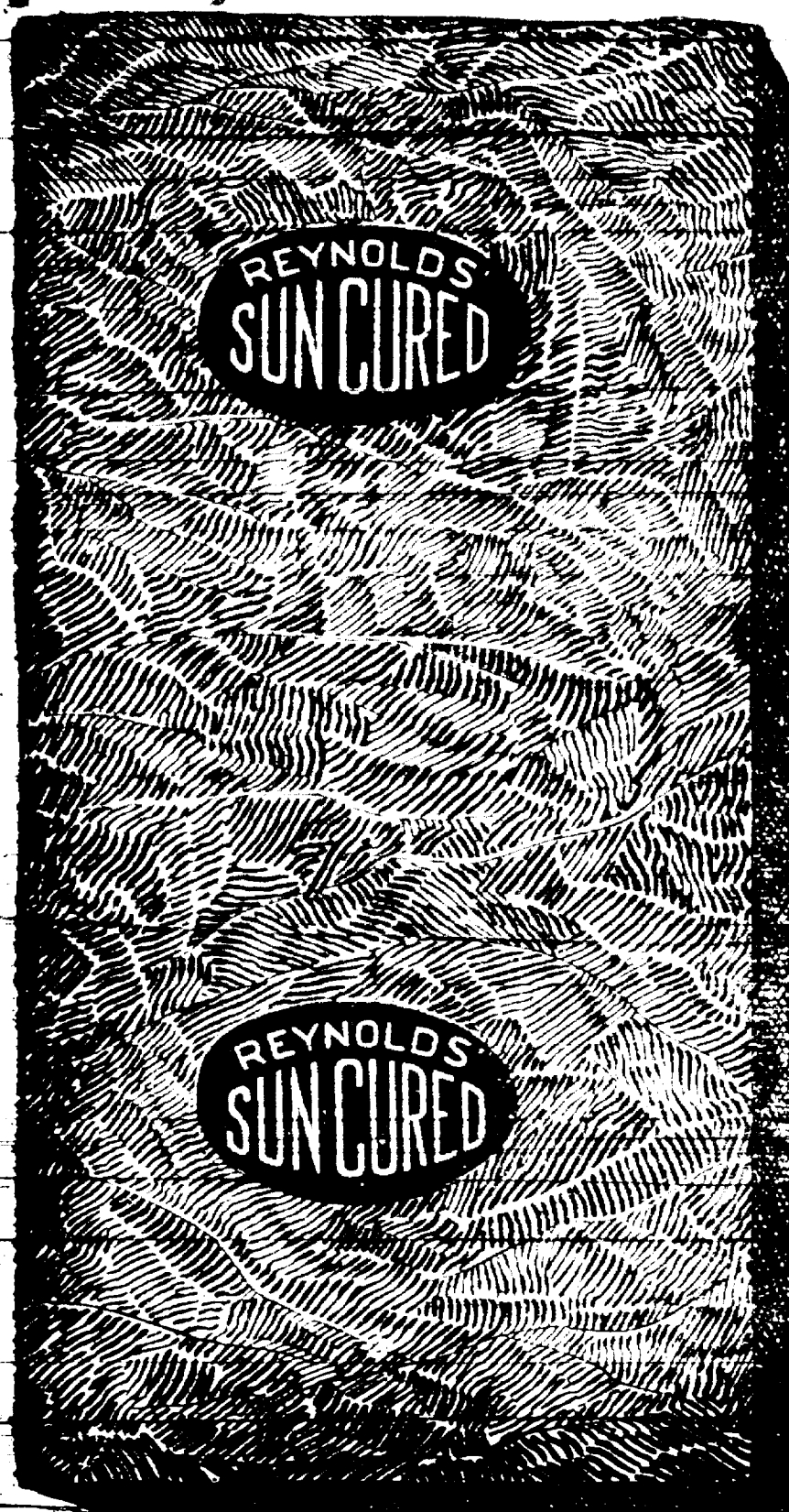

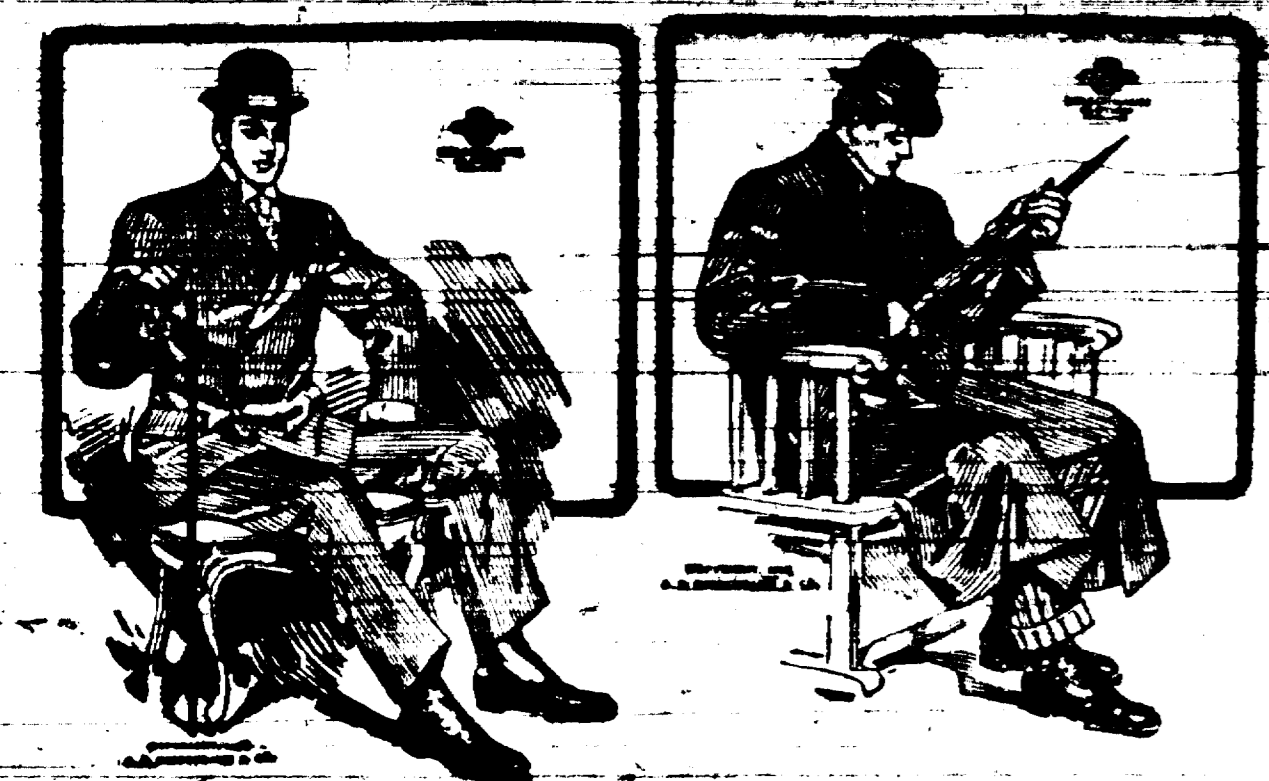

CONGRESSMAN RIXEY AND THE EIGHTH DISTRICT.

From the Alexandria Morning News.

About the time Congress adjourned Mr. Rixey, the able and efficient representative from this district, was advised, on account of some slight throat trouble, to spend the summer in Colorado. He speeded to return to Virginia about the first of September, but the climate of Colorado proving so beneficial his friends have persuaded him to remain there a few weeks longer until his cure is complete. His political work in this district has been delayed but by the middle of the month, he writes his friends, he expects to be at home and to enter actively into the campaign.

Mr. Rixey need give himself no concern regarding politics in his district. His return to congress is so sure that the republicans are taking no interest whatever in the approaching election and the West. Mr. Rixey has already said that the time is not yet come for the election of a republican congressman in this district.

We are glad Mr. Rixey is not canvassing the district. If he is not well enough known to the people whom he has served by this time he will never be, besides why should either he or the people be subjected to a "campaigning."

During every session of Congress Mr. Rixey has been found at his post of duty every day. No man in Congress to-day is more industrious and painstaking in public service, and on several occasions Mr. Rixey has gained a national reputation, notably in the case of his aggressive fight against naval extravagance.

Certainly if Mr. Rixey needs rest and recuperation there is no reason why he should campaign in this county. A man should go to the polls from a sense of duty as a citizen. He owes this to his country, his home and himself. And certainly we of the South need our level-headed business men in public service, and such Mr. Rixey has proven himself to be.

In any event the man who underestimates Hearst as a political factor is making a serious mistake. However much we may deride his spectacular methods, his extravagant disregard of journalistic decency, his self obtrusiveness, and worst of all his brutal agitations, in arraying class against class and man against his fellow the fact remains that Hearst has a big following and a prodigious campaign fund of his own that knows no conscience. He ought not to win but he may.

A Wave of Radicalism.

There is a wave of radicalism in politics sweeping over the country that is bringing about some startling situations. It is not confined to the democratic party only, but petty radicals of the republican party, who the spirits have been loosed and cannot again be chained. Those of us who advocated politics now stand amazed as the crowd sweeps on, instead on upheaval such as we had never dreamed of. Even Bryan for a time seemed like to be classed permanently, and was momentarily classed, as a conservative.
