Election at Large.

Elections were held Tuesday in forty-two states.

The republicans retain control of the house of congress by about 100.

In New York Hughes, republican, while running nearly all of the principal cities, and in the state, repudiated his former government by about one-half.

The first district brought about the

republican victory in the New York City

Tammany Independent League, which

was taken over by the republicans,

with only one exception, over the

candidates named by the nonpartisan

Judicial nominating committee.

The democrats elected all their

candidates in New York state except

Hearst.

Cyrus Grinnell, Jr., representative, re-

feated John D. Morris for governor of

Massachusetts by more than 30,

000 votes.

Connecticut re-elected its republi-

cans officials.

Rhode Island swung back into the

democratic column, electing

Higgs.

New Hampshire apparently elects

Floyd, but his plurality is so small

the legislature must pass upon the

result.

New York elected Hughes, repre-

sented over Hearst.

California elected Gillett, and

incidentally showed under the

Hearst independence candidate, who

was an indifferent third.

Colorado repudiated Alva Adams,

the democrat, who said he was

robbed at the polls at the last election,

and swung well into the re-

publican column.

Iowa was torn by opinions, and

both parties claim the victory.

Michigan gave its usual 100,000

for the republican state ticket.

Bryan's influence could not carry

Nebraska for the democrats, and it

is also republican.

The two Dakotas have elected re-

publican state tickets.

Pennsylvania elected the republican state ticket by an old time republican plurality.

The movement in Philadelphia and through Pennsylvania inaugurated last year as a result of Philadelphia's Great Lease fight received a severe blow in the election. The latest figures show that everywhere in the city and the state the fusion party opposed to the regular republicans were either badly defeated or had its last year's vote greatly reduced.

Tennessee joked with Henry Clay Evans, ex-republican commissioner of pensions, and then defeated him by 15,000 electing by the usual of year plurality the democratic ticket.

Idaho seems to have gone democratic.

Kansas consistently runs its gubernatorial candidate, Hoch, behind in the early hours and came to his rescue in time to ensure his election as an "off year" plurality.

Alabama went democratic.

Mr. Cannon had a hard fight but won out with a plurality of 7,500. At present indications are that the only congressman of national prominence defeated is Jas. W. Wadsworth, called "Beef Trust Jim," because of his opposition to President Roosevelt's packing house reform plans.

Arizona and New Mexico would not stand for President Roosevelt's plan for joint statehood and have defeated the proposition.

Oklahoma, the new state, copied with Indian territory, is a bright new star for the democracy.

Missouri is still in doubt. It is probably democratic but less than half the counties have been heard from. The republicans claim by a small majority, the democrats by 18,000.

Ohio has gone republican by about 75,000. The democrats have elected congressmen in the fourth, fifth, sixth, tenth and seventeenth districts, a gain of four over their present delegation in the House.

Congressman Nicholas Longworth was re-elected in Cincinnati, and was more than a safe bet.
