William Dutcher, chairman of the protection committee of the American Bird Union, says the robin is the farmers' good friend. The stomachs of 330 robins showed on examination by an official of the Department of Agriculture that they contained 42,577 parasites, and less than eight per cent. cultivated fruit. These examinations were made upon birds killed during every month of the year. Horticulturists are advised to protect their orchards by growing a few wild fruits, as the birds prefer them, and will not touch the cultivated kind if the wild can be had. During the month of May over fifty per cent. of the food of the robin is composed of beetles, most of which are harmful to vegetable life, if not altogether destructive.
