THE CRIME OF DISEASE. One-third of Sickness Preventable.

The State Board of Health, with sufficient number of trained inspectors at the schools and in factories, slaughter-houses and public places...

"You had in Virginia 2,700 deaths from consumption, according to the inaccurate statistics furnished."

"I am here to tell you that consumption is not necessarily inherited. You can not have it unless you get into your body the germs from outside living matter."

"If the expectorated matter from all present consumptives could be collected and destroyed for a generation, you would never have another case of consumption in Virginia."

"You had in Virginia last year 1,324 deaths from the kind of intestinal diseases which come from drinking dirty, adulterated and impure milk."

"In the examination in New Jersey, fifty-three specimens of milk were examined and were found to be dangerously adulterated. There is now very little chance to get pure milk in this country, as it is almost habitually adulterated."

"In Louisville we took thirty-three specimens from wagons on the street and found every one of them adulterated, and ninety-one warrants were issued for dairymen last week in that city."

"Of the 100,000 cows that supply milk to New York city, over 3,000 have tuberculosis. It would be cheaper to have supervision over the milk supply than to bury the babies."

IS PUBLIC DISGRACE? "You had in Virginia last year over 900 deaths from typhoid. This is not only a preventable disease, but it is a disgrace. It is a disgrace to any one and to any family to have a case of typhoid fever."

"You can get a case of typhoid except from the kidney or bowel excretions of another case. Where the excretions of one case are thrown out in a public place, there is no limit to the number of cases that may ensue."

"In towns typhoid is carried almost entirely by flies. Flies only breed in horse stables, and may be easily prevented by mixing lime with the fertilizer."

"We have had before the people month after month a plea to screen the kitchens and dining-rooms of their houses; but most people prefer to employ a doctor, take his vile stuff, and pay his bill, rather than use a little preventive work."

"What possible interest can doctors have in the passage of laws like this?"

"All professions do altruistic work. The lawyers, ministers and doctors of Virginia do more Christian charity work than all others put together."

"The noblest specimens of God's manhood, go from hell to hell, heavening God's poor. There is nothing like it under the sun. Doctors take an oath that if they ever make a discovery that will benefit suffering humanity it will be given to the public without money and without price."

"Wherever in the calling the members of the professions were segregated this envy, cramped out. Now we have condemnations and gratings of all sorts bringing professional men together."

"Society has a right to demand that the cure of disease be made possible without the women. We must call on anything unless they are paid in advance. The lawyers have gone into the Legislature and into the courts and into the executive offices, and have made laws and construed them and executed them."

"Had doctors been equally as conscientious as the lawyers, the health of the nation would have been as good as that of the United States Supreme Court."

"The board of health, with its various committees, making continual investigations into the cause of dis-


