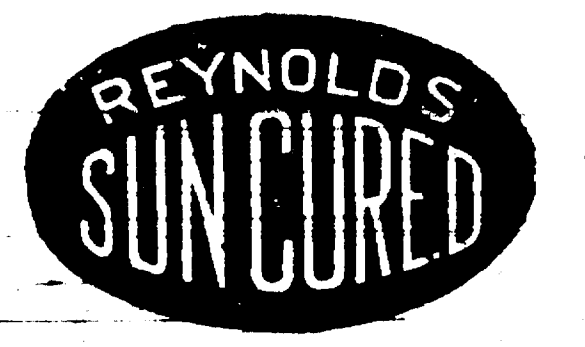

SMALL BREEDS FOR EGGS.

A Writer Who Thinks That Large Fowls Are Not Most Profitable. The largest profits do not always lie in the greatest amount of money obtained for an article, the cost of production, and the net gain very materially.

I think to one who will dispute me, says with L. Clark in American Poultry Journal, when I say it will require nearly double the amount of feed to keep a dozen of these working from six to ten pounds each than would be required to keep the same number weighing, say, three and one-half or four pounds each, and at the same time these smaller breeds cannot be overfed when it comes to smelting out eggs.

Mr. Clark goes on to say, "without point in favor of the smaller breeds is that less room is required, both in the pen and in the yard. And a larger number can be kept on the same acre. The Hamburg has always been my favorite, and they are certainly the lightest feeders and greatest bustlers of any breed that has ever come under my observation, and yet combine beauty and egg production to a marked degree, having long been known as 'everlasting layers'."

It is not already established in the poultry business and are satisfied with the breed you have, do not change. Stick to them, resolved to give them a little better care in the future, and success will be yours.

But if you are just about to begin, with a view to egg production, try some one of the smaller breeds, and I believe at the end of the year when you come to balance up receipts and expenditures that the results will not prove disappointing.

Buyer's Hen Chick. "Uncle" Michael K. Boyer, the "man of practical poultrymen," has the following chunks of wisdom in Farm Journal: The mortgage lifting hen is in evidence. One year's experience does not make an expert poultryman. Dility is the science and beauty of the art of poultry keeping.

"Trusted thinking and wise working" is the keynote of success. The success you will have with poultry depends upon the care you will give.

Open the doors and windows of the poultry house each fine day and let in the sun and fresh air. An abundant supply of poultry products of the highest class would undoubtedly lead to an increased consumption.

The poultry business is comparatively easy to learn by ambitious, energetic persons, and it is this class alone that will gain marked success.

"This is a practical country," writes Judge G. O. Brown, "and breeding fowls for meat, fancy or beauty, none will never become popular. Beauty and utility should be twin in poultry raising."

Don't Crowd the Chickens. Not more than fifty chicks should be put together in one brooder, and in two weeks these should be divided into two lots of twenty-five each. The first ten-day chicks are put together they are very liable to crowd and when in the center become overheated and when exposed to the air become chilled and die. A lot of trouble and various other diseases set in and the chicks die very rapidly from an apparent cause.

Extra Early Chicks. If you are not restricted to give extra early chicks the right kind of care and housing, better wait patiently for their wagner for the first hatch. It is great gain to have time and money to hatch out the extra early chicks unless you can give them the conditions necessary to keep them in best shape and growing rapidly.

Don't For Bull Cockin Breeders. Don't breed a cocker that shows red on white legs.

Don't breed from pullets showing white in undercolor of neck. Don't breed from the birds that feather and develop slowly, as such birds will greatly reduce the value of the stock.

Food For Ducklings. The proper food for young ducklings depends upon their age. When from one to five days old they need boiled egg and lettuce or cabbage finely chopped. After that age need preference given to oatmeal and rice mixture in the proportion until they are three to four weeks old. Then grain in their water.

The Scratching Shed. A scratching shed should be built tight so that the fowls are sheltered from the wind. The south side should be open, or a very good ditch covered with light manure or other such cloth.

Feeding Beef Blood to Poultry. Beef blood should be given to poultry in a quantity of one quart to one gallon of water, once a week.
