M. Clarkson, in faultless rhetoric, and a pathetic selection, entitled 'Just Before the Battle Mother,' sung by Mr. G. Raymond Ratcliffe and Reva, H. U. Rupp and H. S. Willey, were specially enjoyed.

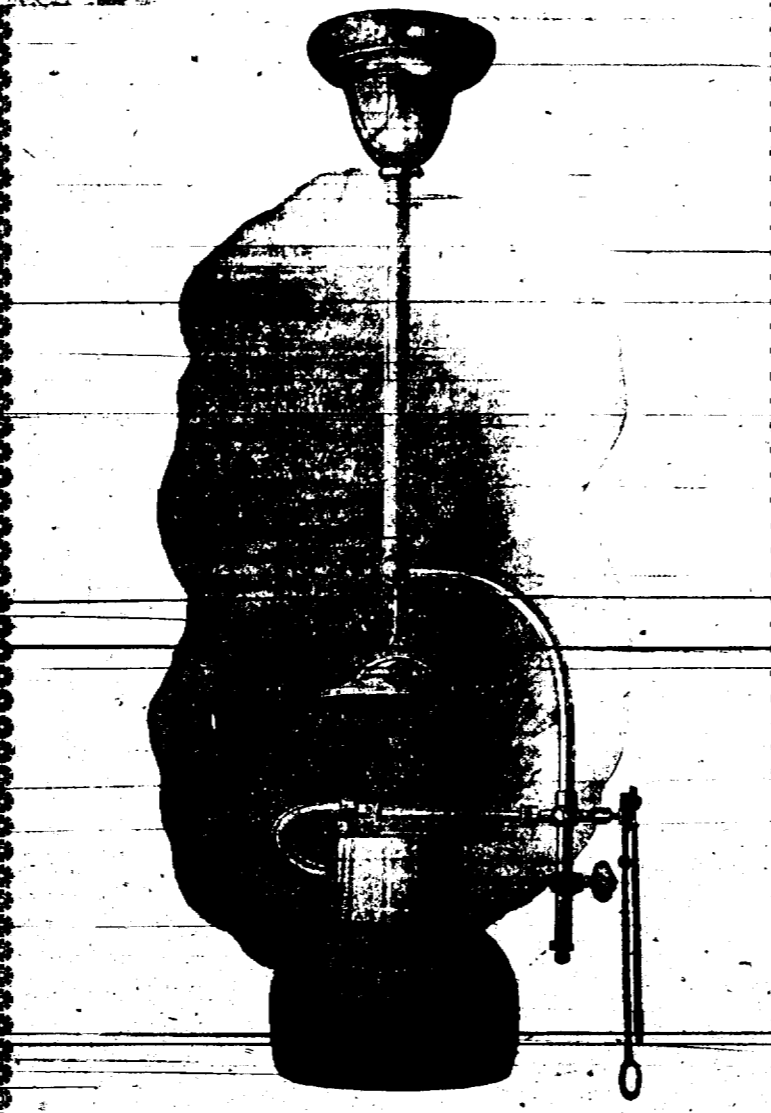

As each member present answered to his name the answer came in a husky voice that betokened thoughts that stirred the inmost souls of those gray-haired, battle-scarred heroes of many hard-fought battles.

The exercises closed with the singing of 'Old Folks at Home' by the assembly, followed by the benediction by Rev. Chas. L. DeLong, pastor of the M. E. Church, South, of Manassas.

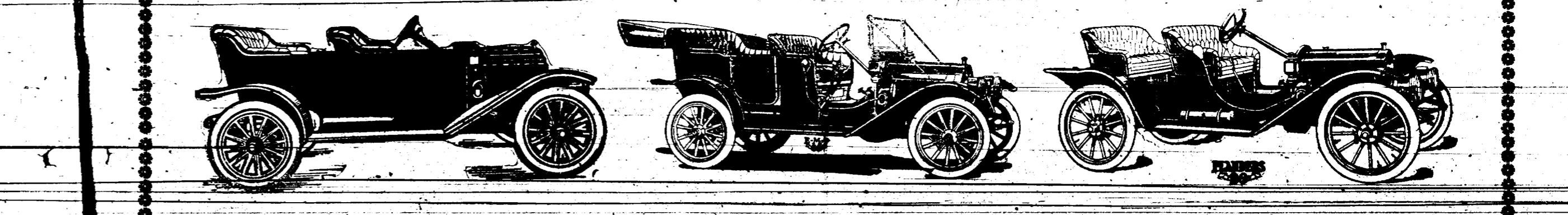

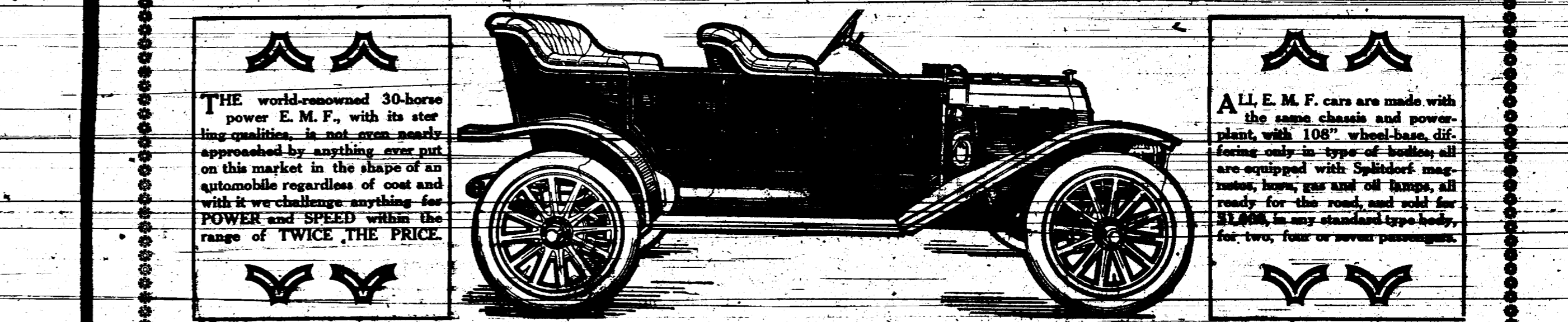
