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PARCELS POST PROBLEMS

What the System Would Mean to Country Towns and Local Trade.

The advocates of the rural parcels post claim that this system of merchandise transportation would enable the farmer to have small packages of merchandise delivered at his mail box quickly and cheaply.

No one disputes this—but there are two more sides to the question. Here is one:

Every rural delivery carrier is now authorized to carry merchandise parcels weighing over four pounds from your farm to town or from town to your farm—and you or the town man, pay the carrier whatever you agree is right.

The opportunity thus afforded these mail-order houses for the development of a gigantic trust is a most serious menace to the farmer's welfare.

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WOULD WIPE OUT SENATE

Representative Lindbergh, of Minnesota, has introduced, according to Associated Press dispatches, a resolution in the House to abolish the United States Senate, and further, of course, to make null and void the office of Vice-president of the Nation.

He takes another step and says that the membership of the House shall be reduced to 300 and that they shall be elected for seven years, and to create a "committee of fifteen" elected from the country at large, every member to be subject to the machinations of the recall—and that this arrangement shall run the country.

In addressing the House, Mr. Lindbergh said that the Senate was no longer "responsive to the people." As a matter of fact, the Senate is the controlling force of the legislative department of the national government, just as the Senate of this State, no longer ago than the recent session, saved her from many a humiliation.

So, just as the Senate of this Old Dominion stands sponsor for the Mother of States, and will not allow anything to touch her reputation, so the United States Senate, in argut assembly, sits in judgment upon the wild-cat schemes, foolhardiness, perversion of good government, not to say anarchy, that is proposed by men whom it is a mystery to us to be in Congress.

The great northwest may be proud of Mr. Lindbergh, but we express no feeling of appreciation.

We are, however, pained to know that the over-worked "fool-killer," has at last been forced to quit his business.
