PEACE JUBILEE GREAT SUCCESS

Fiftieth Anniversary of Battle of Bull Run Celebrated—Blue and Gray Clash Hands Across the 'Bloody Chasm'

In the presence of thousands of people the reunion and peace jubilee took place on historic Bull Run plains from 9 to 5 p. m.

Gov. Mann, accompanied by his staff and escorted by the Front Royal Guards, arrived on the grounds shortly before noon and was chief orator of the occasion.

VETERANS SHAKE HANDS IN FIELD


The Manassas Horse Show was a pronounced success. The weather was all that could be wished and brought a crowd of over 2,700 on the first day—the largest for ten years.

VIRGINIA NEWS

The cordial reception given Congressman William A. Jones when he spoke at Charlottesville last week has aroused the supporters of Senator Martin who have planned a big rally, to be held at the courthouse on Monday night, Aug. 7.

The white potato crop of Cape Charles is now about finished up. The yield for this county was about two-thirds of that of last year, but the money returns in profits to the truckers have been several times as great. As a consequence the truckers are feeling fine and many mortgages are being paid off. The county will be in better shape financially than for a number of years past.

The good roads movement, led in Congress by Virginia's junior senator, seems to have received additional momentum by President Taft's experience in reaching Manassas on the 21st over some "specimen" roads in his automobile—from a sentimental standpoint, at least. But of practical interest is the automobile trip through Virginia this week under the auspices of the Touring Club of America and the American Association for Highway Improvement. P. St. Julian Wilson, state highway commissioner of Virginia, was among the autoists.

The State Board of Education has adopted regulations regarding university, collegiate and academic teachers' certificates and the classification of institutions granting baccalaureate and graduate degrees. A definite definition of a university, of a college and of an academy is given. The holder of a degree from the graduate school of a registered university shall be granted a twelve-year certificate for teaching in the public schools of the state. The holder of a baccalaureate degree from a registered college shall be granted a ten-year certificate for teaching in the public schools of the state and an academic certificate shall be good 8, 7, 5 or 3 years according to the rank of the school granting the certificate. These regulations do not pertain to the State Normal Schools.

CURRENT EVENTS

California has a new law that sends a man to jail when he fails to support his family. He is then put to work in the streets and \$1.50 a day is paid to his family. The women interested in the progress of the sex are jubilant over the law and hope it will be adopted in every State in the Union.

The Canadian reciprocity bill emerged unscathed from the most serious ordeal it has yet experienced in the senate. The series of amendments offered by Senator Cummins of Iowa and the two offered by Senator Simmons of North Carolina, all seeking to increase the number of Canadian manufactured articles that shall be admitted to the United States free of duty, were voted down by large majorities.

Seventy-six years ago Atha G. Hudson, 22 years old, and his fiancée, 15, ran away to a Baptist parsonage, near Nashville, Tenn., and were married. Today Mr. Hudson, almost 98 years old, and his wife, 90, celebrated their wedding anniversary at Humansville, Mo. A quaint contract was made by the Hudsons shortly after they were married. Its object was to prevent either being humiliated at the same time. Mr. Hudson says they never had a real quarrel.

Special correspondence of the New York Evening Post, from Washington, has the following story on the surviving generals of the Confederacy. Brigadier General Marcus J. Wright, who is one of the surviving generals of the Confederate Army, now employed in the War Department, has for years kept the records of the 425 generals appointed by President Davis. According to his record, only twenty-five of this number are now alive.

The battleship North Dakota, one of the biggest of Uncle Sam's floating batteries, completed eighteen months ago at a cost of \$10,000,000, has been lying helpless at the Brooklyn Navy Yard for two months. In plain English the ship is crippled by a great stubborn piece of steel, which cannot be budged by all the powerful machinery which has been yanking at it in the attempt to extricate it. More technically speaking, the rotor of one of the North Dakota's turbine engines is jammed. The steel rotor covers the other parts of a turbine engine's mechanism and revolves with the shaft. If further efforts to raise the rotor be unsuccessful, it will be necessary to dismember a large part of the battleship's machinery.

In the hearing of testimony in the Lewis case recently it was charged by General Madden that the Post Office Department has established postal regulations contrary in conflict with the status. Speaking of the "hold up" of \$60,000 copies of the Woman's Farm Journal in 1906 by Postmaster Frank Wyman, Madden declared Wyman is subject to jail sentence for that act. Madden said it came within the provisions of a law providing a fine and jail sentence for postmasters who unlawfully delay mails. Also, Madden declared, it was a secret "hold up." Lewis not being advised his papers were being handled by the post office since five weeks after he had submitted them and had paid \$700 covering the postage at the second-class rate. Chairman Ashbrook expressed surprise that the Post Office Department should take such a course secretly, and said in his judgment Lewis is entitled to \$700 refund. Madden said the money had never been repaid, and that the total amount Lewis had thus paid at different times, none of which had been refunded, had amounted to more than \$29,000.

Finding of the Law

Reading School Lesson for July 28, 1911. Specially Arranged for This Paper.

LESSON TEXT—II Chronicles 34:14-22. MEMORIZE VERSE 17. GOLDEN TEXT—"Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee."—Psalm 119:11. TIME—H. C. 21, in the 15th year of Josiah's reign, when he was 26 years old. PLACE—The Temple and Palace at Jerusalem. PERSONS—Josiah the king, Hilkiah the high priest, Shaphan the scribe or secretary. With hundreds of millions of Bibles in existence and several millions more printed every year, it is somewhat difficult for us to imagine how knowledge of the written Bible, and of the exact truth of its teachings, would be lost. Some facts will help us to understand. There were at that time very few copies of the sacred books in existence. They were very carefully guarded and were customary for these copies to be kept in the temple, while the copy which (according to the law) was made for the use of the king, would most certainly have perished. The such things as Hilkiah and Shaphan. It is plain that the finding of this book "was not the discovery of something unknown before, but the rescue of the genuine copy of the law from the hiding place in which it had long lain." It must have been the ancient copy of the law, and not a book written, as some critics think, by Hilkiah. And do not let us think that the law never seen or used among the Jews before.

When they brought out from the chests in the temple the many copies of the law, which had been deposited in the safe-hiding place, Hilkiah the priest, who had charge of the money in searching the books found at the bottom of a box of the law of the Lord, the law given by Moses. Hilkiah delivered the book to Shaphan, King Josiah's secretary of state, as the fitting person to show it to the king. When Shaphan reported to the king, he brought the book with him, told how it had been found, and read it to the king.

When he heard the book read, he assembled the elders and priests, and the Levites. They made a public covenant and pledge. The King himself first made a public covenant before the people, and then the elders, the Levites, and the people, all joined in the covenant, and to keep his commandments, with all his heart.

This was very similar to the great covenant which was made at the foot of Mount Sinai, and which was the basis of the covenant made at the foot of the Promised Land. The same motives were presented, and the same covenant was made, and the same promises were given.
