SHE SCORES AGED 'VAMPS.'

Head of Christian Homes, Dr. Barrett, Decries Examples Set by Elders. "When sixty-year-old women are posing as young girls, you cannot expect much of young girls," declared Dr. Kate Walker Barrett, national president of the Florence Crittenden Homes.

"I have been forced to the point of questioning whether women are better guardians of morals than men," said Mrs. Barrett. "When Mrs. Thomas, of Philadelphia, deigns cigarette smoking among women because it gives an additional point of contact with men, and prominent women talk about the right to moral freedom, we are completely questioning whether women are arriving at the single standard of morals, by lowering themselves to the standard of men."

"Girls were formerly admitted into our homes at the average age of twenty-eight; now they are admitted at the average age of sixteen. I have six little girls under ten in my charge, physically and morally ruined. I am at a loss to understand this glaring change, unless it be a national loquacity of standards in our homes. Perhaps the new freedom has been temporarily too much for many women, and we shall hope for a sane readjustment."
