T. L. Rollins and Early Griffith, trustees of the Maymarket Baptist church, to hold such property in virtual trust for the Antioch Baptist church in the event it should be re-activated.

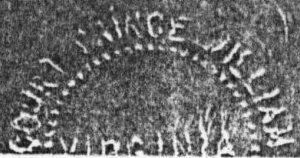
and upon evidence being produced before the Court that it is the wish of the membership mentioned in said Petition to turn over the real property and funds of the said Antioch Baptist church to the trustees of the Maymarket Baptist church, it is ADJUDGED, ORDERED AND DECIDED that the said Quentin Lawler, J. T. L. Rollins and Early Griffith, be named trustees in the place and stead of John Costello, Joseph Owens and Herman Smith, to hold title to all real property of the Antioch Baptist church and the Women's Missionary Society of the Antioch Baptist church, conditioned upon their returning the said property to the Antioch Baptist church or its trustees at such time as the Antioch Baptist church should be reactivated.
