
None of the 4 sites marked by Frances Jones are the Arrelton site. The surveyor spoke with several long-time residents of Nokesville and none of them knew where the exact location is. There is a stone foundation of an earlier house in the basement of Fred and Jane Rhoads home at 11486 Bittle Lane. This is an old Meredith house but it could not be the Arrelton house because their house was built circa 1910, and nothing was on the site when it was first surveyed by the W. P. A. in the 1930's.
