House stands on top of elevation above drainage which flows l south into Kettle Run. Road is located on other side (east) of l drainage. Land is open plowed fields bordered by cedars.

Secondary Resource Summary:

There is a mid-twentieth century concrete block shed located l in the yard southeast of the house. A frame well house and two l frame sheds are located in the yard west of the house. All of l these appear to date to the early twentieth century, are clad l with vertical siding and roofed with metal standing seam. l There is a line of three early twentieth century and two late l twentieth century frame sheds located in the yard south of the l house. Two of the historic sheds are small, frame, one-bay, l front-gables. One is clad with weatherboard, the other with l vertical siding. The third historic shed has a shed roof and l is clad with vertical siding. All three are roofed with metal l standing seam. South of the sheds, on the other side of a farm l lane, is a two-story, early twentieth century frame barn with l an overhang on the gable end. It is clad with vertical siding, l is roofed with metal standing seam and stands on a formed l concrete foundation. There is a formed concrete silo l foundation behind the barn. There is an early twentieth l century frame tractor shed located east of the house. It is l
