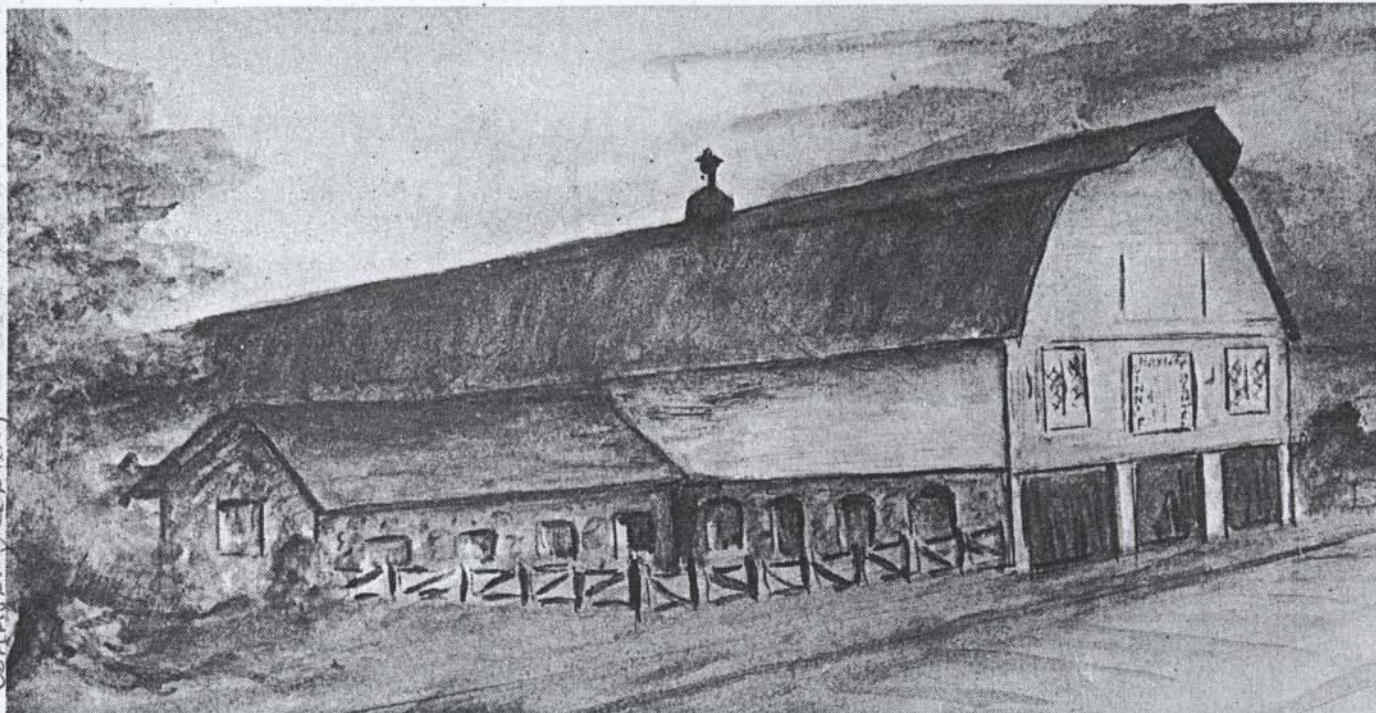

## 'Save the Barn' Pledge Campaign Is Launched

# \$3.85

The School Board can expect some \$900,000 less if it requested from the Supervisors as a result of the tax rate on real property by the board May 13.

In urging the adoption of the \$3.85 rate, Dumfries Supervisor Dr. A. J. Ferlazzo said he could not agree with all of county executive Gregory N. C. Sharp's proposals especially the depletion of the industrial development fund, elimination of 10 police officers, curtailment of library funds and elimination of service personnel.

Dr. Ferlazzo suggested cutting the school budget \$700,000 to \$900,000 could offset the tax levy and restore the items to the county budget.
