## 'Wanna Buy a Barn?'

Don't be too surprised if you're reading the metropolitan classifieds this weekend to stumble upon a small advertisement — miscellaneous for sale — one barn. The only catch is — if you want to buy the barn, you have to pack it up and cart it away.

The decrepit and crumbling Ben Lomond barn that stands as a landmark at the entrance to Sudley is up for sale.

The structure is to be removed to make way for a \$300,000 community center approved by Greater Manassas Sanitary District voters in referendum last November.

In its place will be a two - story structure with a barn - like facade. Smith and Smith, architects for the project, estimate they will have final designs completed by the end of the month.

The Supervisors approved the for-sale advertisements to be placed in the metropolitan papers this weekend after GMSD acting administrator John Sloper requested approval of advertising the structure for salvage yesterday.

"We don't need to take it down (for salvage). Somebody will buy it," said Board Chairman C. Scott Winfield seriously.

If the for sale ad doesn't work, the barn will be advertised for salvage the following week.
