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John Cralle was Mem. Va. Conv., 1776; also Trustee of Heathville, Va. Kenner C. gave bond as Sheriff, North'd Co., 1794. Captain Samuel Crawley, Va. State Navy, Revolutionary War, rec'd 1500 a. land from Va., issued in warrants 7235 to his heirs, Wm. S. and Samuel C. Ware, and 7244 to his heir, Elizabeth C. Ware. (Rep. Sec. Treas., 1834.) Leigh Ware surrendered warrant 7326 for 500 a. land issued for Capt. Samuel C., 1834. (*id.*) This Samuel was pro. No. 16, who d. 1827. Benjamin Crawley appears Petersburg, Va., June 16, 1795. (Coll. Va. Cases, 1815, p. 113.) Richard K. Cralle, of Lunenburg, Va., was ed. W. and M. Coll., 1819-20. A. A. Crawley, C. S. A., and A. B. Crawley, C. S. A., were members Co. C, Black Walnut Troops, Halifax Co., 3d Va. Cav., C. S. A., 1861-5.

EXCURSUS—YATES FAMILY.

1. *Rev. Robert¹ Yates*, a clergyman of the Ch. of Eng., came to Va. 1699; was Rector Christ Ch., Midd'x Co., until ill health caused his return to England, 1703-4. His vestry so highly esteemed him that they continued his salary for some time in hopes of his return. He was succeeded by his son,

2. *Rev. Bartholomew² Yates*, b. 1677; m. Sep. 14, 1704, Sarah Mickelborough, of Midd'x. (M. R.) (DANIEL 3.) He grad. Brazenose Coll., Oxford, Eng., Oct. 12, 1698; ord. and licensed for Va. by the Ld. Bp. of Lond., Sep. 10, 1700. He served the same parish 34 years. "After 18 years of faithful service the parish of York Hampton, a more desirable one, endeavored to obtain his services. The vestry of Christ Ch. raised his salary to 20,000 lb. tobacco, and enlarged and improved his house. For the privilege of doing this they petitioned the Legislature." (M. I., 360.) Mr. B. was a joint patentee with Edwin Thacker of 24,000 a. land S. side Rapid Anne, Spots. Co., July 20, 1722. (Land Bk. II., 147.) Appointed visitor Wm. and M. Coll., 1723, and Prof. of Divinity, 1729. He d. July 26, 1734, æ 57; bur. August 2, 1734. (M. P. Reg.)

Mr. Yates reported to the Commissary in 1705: "I arrived in Va. Feb. the 2d, 1700; had the parishes of Littenborne and Kingsline; removed from last Mar., 1703; licensed by Bishop Complin Sep. 10, 1700; inducted into Christ Ch. Par., Midd'x Co., Mar. 15, 1703, and resided in the Parish. Salary 16,000 lbs. tobacco yearly. Had a house and glebe which I occupied, but had no other cure." Mr. Y. signed the endorsement of Gov. Nicholson, 1705, and remonstrance against Com'r Blair, 1705. Was president at the Va. Council, 1719; appointed on com. to prepare address of respect to Gov. Spotswood. The following letter from Mr. Wm. Dawson, Commissary of the Bp. of London, is a beautiful tribute to his memory. It will be found with an anonymous letter, laudatory of Mr. Y., and a letter from Mr. Y. himself, with a testimonial of his worth from his vestry, in Perry's Virginia Historical Papers, pp. 348-356.

WILLIAM AND MARY, VIRG., Nov. 8, 1734.

MY LORD: I am very sorry to acquaint your Lordship with the great loss we have suffered in the Death of Rev'd Mr. Yates. Piety to God and Beneficence to men, were the only arts of his excellent life. In him Wisdom and goodness were eminently conjoined. In the conscientious discharge of his duty, few ever equalled him, none ever surpassed him. He explained his doctrine by his practice, and taught and led the way to Heaven. He was a mild but an impartial reprover, neither sparing the greatest, nor overlooking the meanest. The sweetness of his temper gained him universal Goodwill, the simplicity of his manners, Modest without Bashfulness, good natured without weakness, Cheerfulness the Result of innocence sparkled in his face. In Expense he was neither profuse or avaricious, in Charity, unbounded, universal. He died on the 26th Day of July, 1734, in the 57th year of his age.
