Thank you for your consideration of the Historical Commission and the Park Authority desire to keep the old Manor House property in tact.


Enclosed is the plat map upon which we have indicated the desired location for the Slave Quarters.

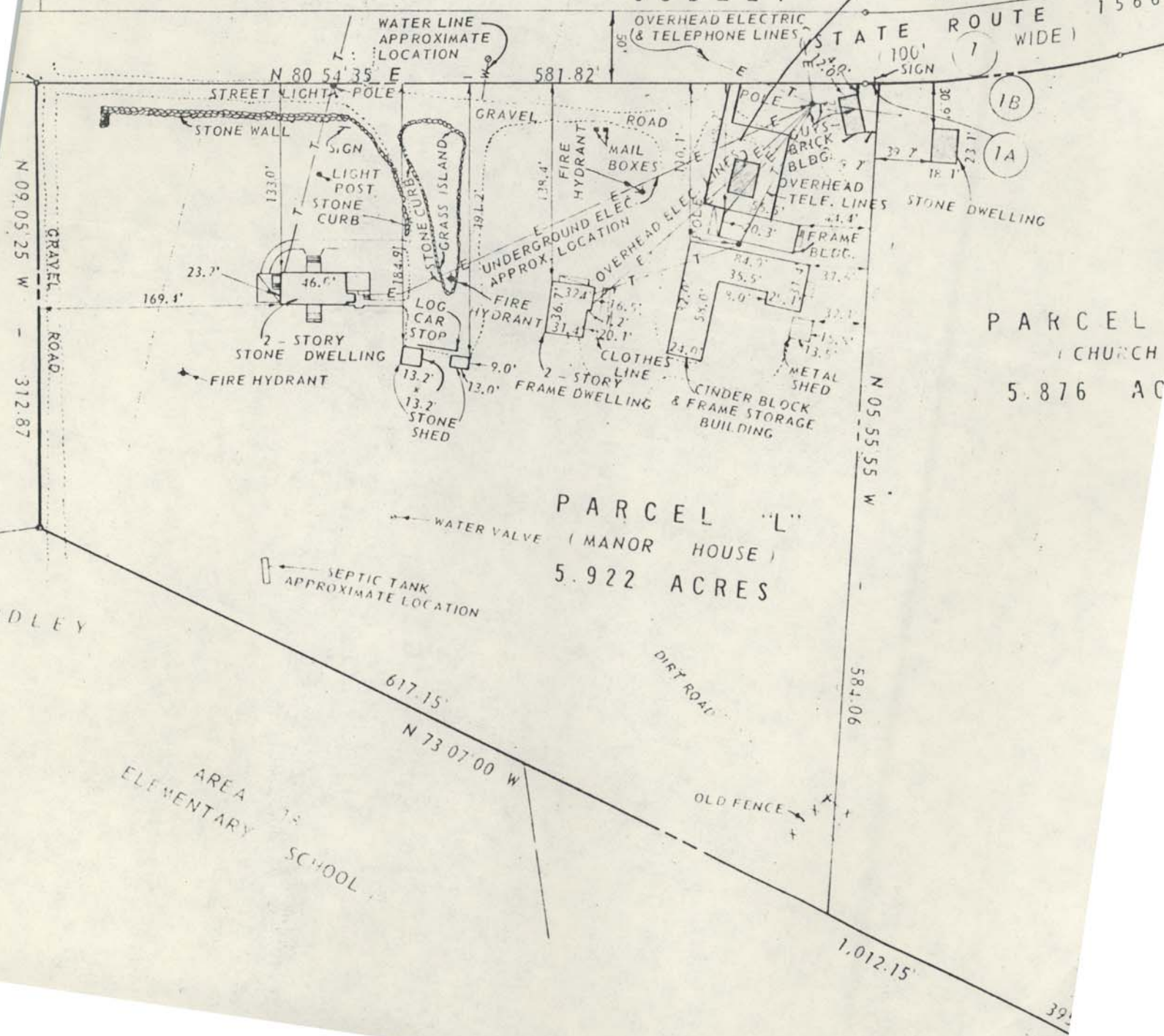
