

Southeast of the house, on Smith Lane, is a community cemetery containing the graves of Hazens, Hornbakers, Wolvertona, Bodines, and Mitchells, ~~and~~ among others. According to one source, ^{near the house,} there are unmarked graves of soldiers killed during the Civil War, though this has not been verified.

The present owner purchased Bradley in 1972 from the heirs of Mrs. Thelma Barnard. The Barnards had owned the property since the 1930s.
