Here is a little tidbit of information for your Brentsville Court House file. I found while researching old business records that the county bought the bell for Brentsville Courthouse from J. Register & Sons, Baltimore Bell and Brass Works, Nos. 53 & 55 N. Holliday Street, Baltimore MD, November 17, 1877. The price for the bell was \$37.75 and another \$14.00 for fixtures. The freight charges were \$1.07 cents for a 157 pound bell. The payment for the bell was by Mr. W. W. Kincheloe (county treasurer at that time) 15 Dec 1877.
