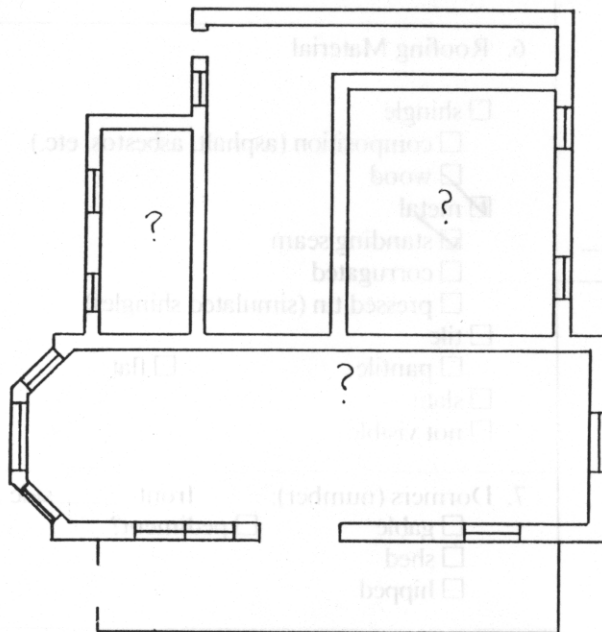

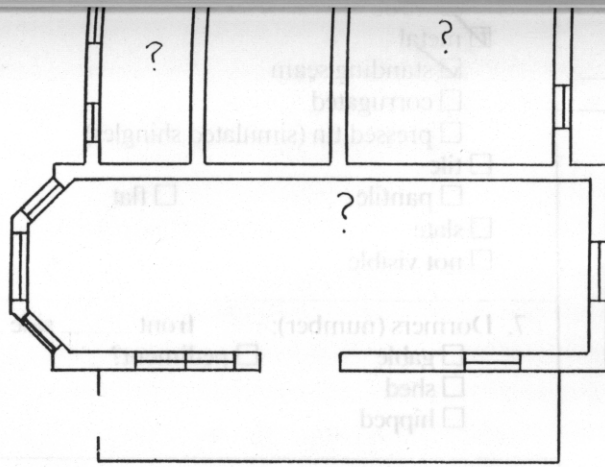


Sketch of Site Plan

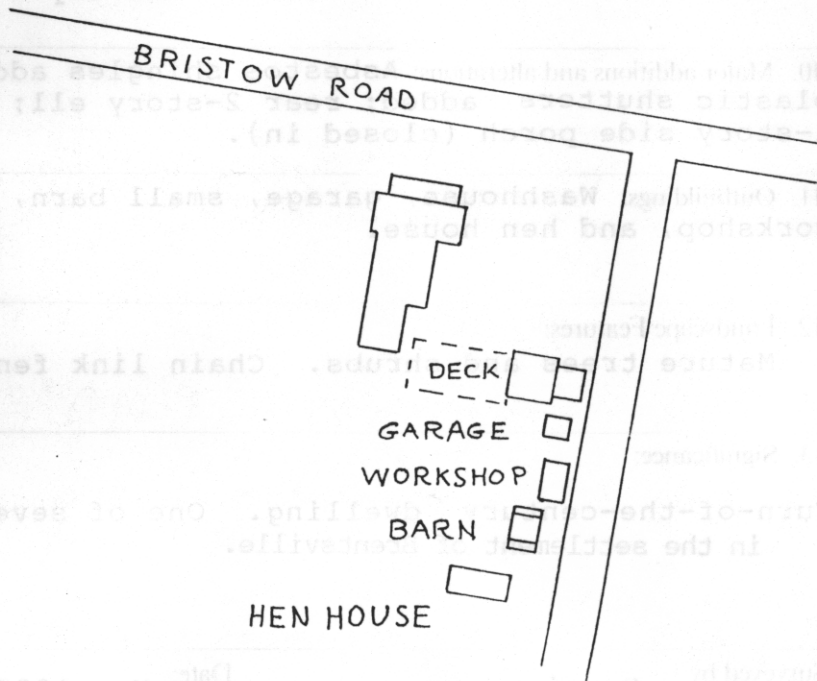
