


BULL RUN REG LIB



At the request of Chrs. O. P. Phelps & Chas. H. Hunter I have
divided the tract of land (represented by the above Plan) into the property of Maj. Hunter (dead)
as follows viz. Lot No. 1 Begins at (N) the Center of a Cattlestop on the orange & Alex. Rail road
in ex. out line of the entire tract also Cowhouse Woods line thence with said line N 70° E 250.6 poles.
to (E) a stake near an old ditch & on the East side of a W. fence, thence along oblique side of said fence N 70° E
160.0 poles to the junction of the Bristow & Milford roads then bearing the out line & running with the Haymarket
road N 28° W 84.8 poles to (O) the center of said road where the same ex. of the rail road thence along
the sh. center of the rail road N 53° W 22.0 poles to the begin^g containing 167. Acre 3 rods & 10 poles exclusive of 6.4 rods
2.4 poles of the rail road. — Lot No. 2 Begins at (A) a planted stone in the Haymarket road come
to Edwin Gaines thence down down said road N 50° E 99.4 poles to (B) the center of said road where it intersects
the rail road, then full width said road N 32° E 36 poles N 28° E 84.8 poles to (C) the junction of the Haymarket

intersection of two fences in an out line of the tract thence with said line N 70° E 64.4 poles to (F) the Center of
a Cattlestop on the orange & Alex. Rail road in said line, thence along the center of the rail road
N 53° E 22.0 poles to the center of the Haymarket road, thence with the Haymarket road N 88° W 99.4 poles
(G) a planted stone in said road come to Edwin Gaines, N 22.4 W 25.46 poles to (H) a stone on the S. W.
bank of said road then bearing the road & running with a line of fence N 38° W 26.97 poles to the begin^g & contains
186 Acres 1 rod & 11 poles exclusive of 3 acres 1 rod & 26 poles rail road. — Lot No. 4 begins at
(I) a stone standing in the B. river, and thence along said road & binding with the out lines of the tract
N 36° W 127.4 poles to (J) a white oak near the S. E. side of said road to which a gate is hung, comes to Cowhouse Woods thence
N 70° E 133.4 poles (K) a stake & dogwood bush at the intersection of two fences in an out line of the tract, thence across the
tract with a line of fence N 38° E 26.97 poles to (L) a stone on the S. W. bank of the Haymarket road & comes to the tract
thence with the out line & said road N 87° W 9.6 poles N 53° W 44.8 poles to (M) the intersection of the said Haymarket road with
the Greenwich road, thence up said Greenwich road N 36° W 147.4 poles to (N) a pile of stones in the meet angle of the
Greenwich & Bristow roads then said the Bristow road leaving the out line, N 29° W 10.8 poles N 53° W 11.4 poles
N 50° W 16.6 poles N 36° W 6.8 poles to the begin^g & contains 24.3 Acres 2 rods & 16 poles. — Part of land off three
Wood Lots & numbered each the same as the other. Lot 1 begins at (P) a stack of stones
in a hedge of rocks in the Greenwich road in an out line thence N 36° W 13.95 poles (Q) another stack of piles of
stones in an out line of the tract, thence with said line N 50° W 0.3 poles (R) a stack two ft from & on the center of
a hollow Spanish oak in said line thence bearing said line N 36° E 11.8 poles to (S) a stone pole in the Greenwich
