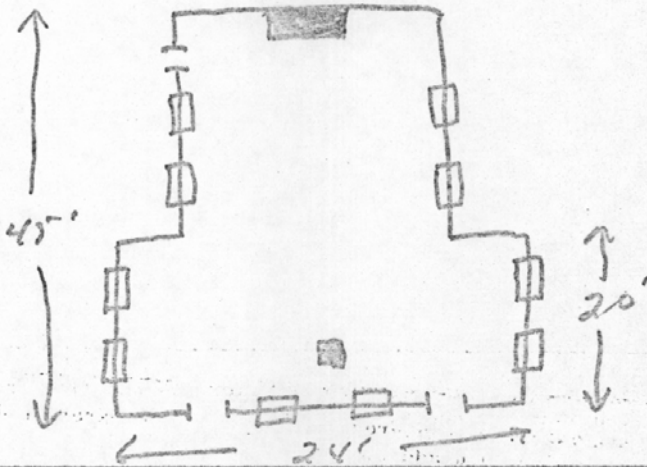

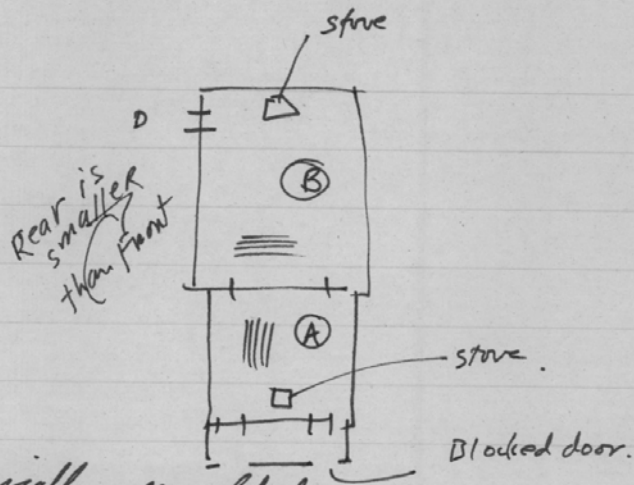

Trim in (A) is asymmetrically-moulded with cornerblocks. Wainscoting is about 3 feet high beaded tongue and groove boards arch has sym. m. trim w/ cornerblocks.

(B) has plain trim with a single "bead" and "5-foot high" matchboard wainscoting.

Interior walls are wall board painted cream-color & textured.
