9. General supplementary description and decoration:  
Entrance stoop with iron railing, reached by high stone steps. Plain cornice. Large brick chimney north gable end; smaller brick chimney on wing.

10. Major additions and alterations: brick chimney on wing. 2-story frame addition at rear (west) side.

11. Out-buildings:  
Log cabin moved to site in 1973, 10'x12'. 2 dilapidated vertical-board storage buildings, 1 gable-roofed, 1 shed-roofed.

12. Landscape features: Small front and south side yards, spacious north side yard, steeply sloping rear yard. Large trees, shrubs, grass.

13. Significance: Its pivotal location at the intersection of Buckland Mill Road with the Lee Highway, as well as its 19th-century use as a tavern, make this a major feature of the Buckland Historic District.
