One-story shed -roof addition at rear, with
large, modern wood deck attached, both
extending entire length of house.

One-story, 3-bay frame cabin with vertical
board siding, gable roof, 3-bay front porch.
Constructed ca. 1975 for storage.

12. Landscape Features:

Post-and-rail fence encloses property on
north, south and west sides, with Broad Run
forming east boundary. Mature trees, shrubs,
13. Significance: and extensive front and rear lawns.

Early and important building in Buckland his-
tory. Served as post office, store and distil-
lery in mid-19th century.
