


The present owners are interested in preserving the historical qualities and present appearance of Buckland, a late-18th, early 19th century mill town and waggoner's stop. Buckland Tavern sits at the entrance to this former town on Rt. 29/211. This road has already been widened once, to the detriment of both the town and this handsome stone house, which has been carefully restored and is well-maintained by the owners. Several other residents support the idea of creating a historic district in Buckland to preserve its unique historical character.
