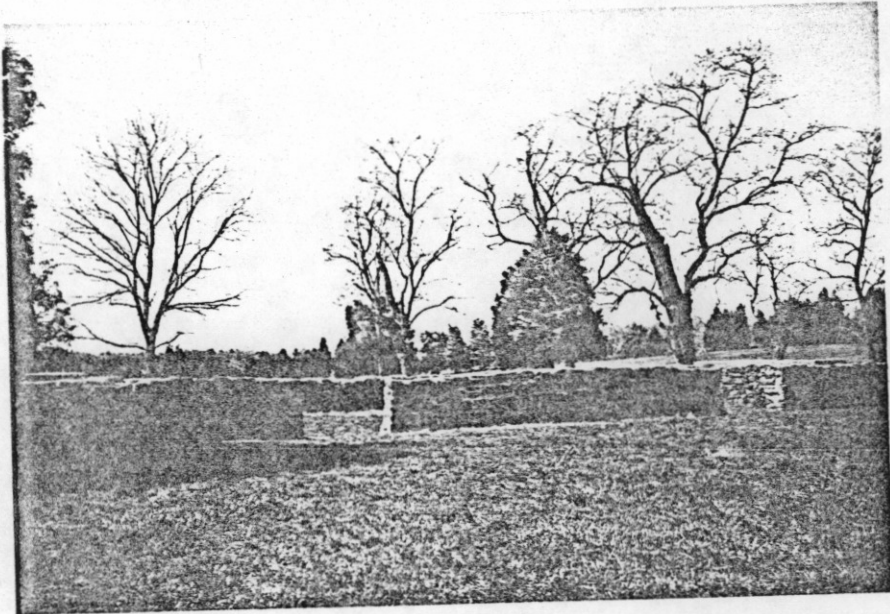

SITE OF THE CHINN HOUSE

The stone foundation on this hilltop is all that remains of the Chinn House, a large 2-story frame residence built reputedly in the late eighteenth century. The house derived its name from Benjamin T. Chinn who purchased the property in 1853.

The rolling hills of the Chinn Farm were the scene of heavy fighting in the battles of First and Second Manassas (Bull Run). In each instance the Chinn House served as a field hospital.
