Description:

This is a frame, shingled vernacular Gothic Revival church with low walls, a steeply pitched roof and a vestibule/bell tower on the right front corner. There is a large stained glass, pointed arch window on the front of the building. It includes a frame tracery which breaks the arch down into three steeply pointed arches and three. The front door is balanced with a narrow pointed arch on the left front. The corners of the building are enlarged with decorative buttresses. There is a rank of three narrow pointed arches in the upper story of the bell tower. The tower is capped with a pyramidal roof with triangular, gable vents on each side. There are four arched casement windows on each side. The wall on the back half of the south side projects out some two feet from the main body of the building.

A series of three mid-twentieth century, concrete block, one and two-story additions are located on the back of the church.

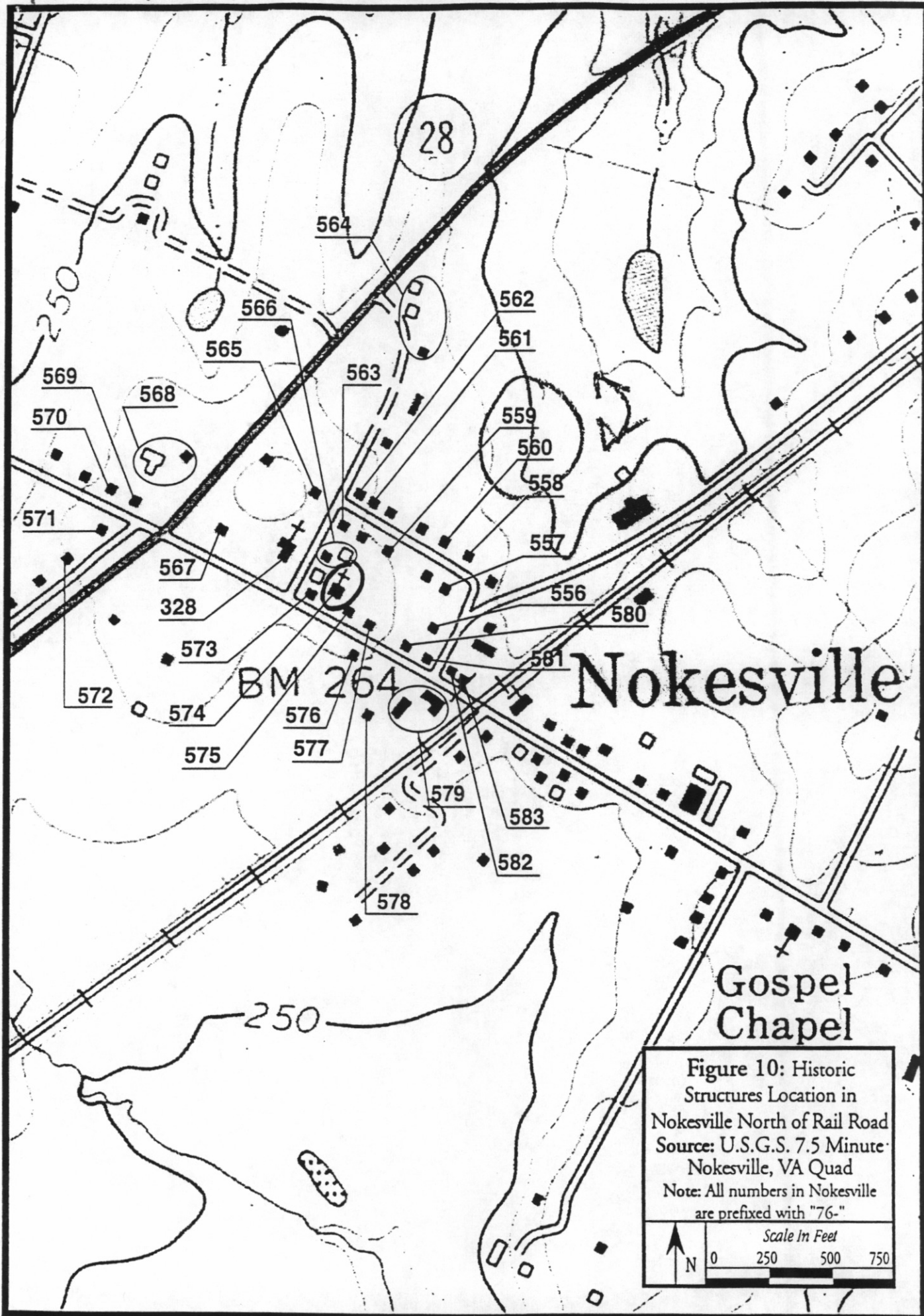

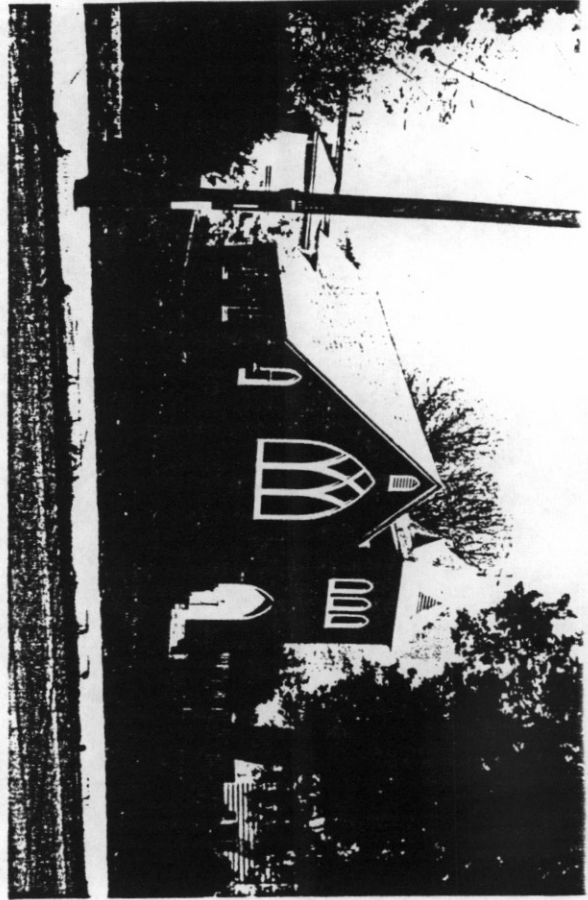

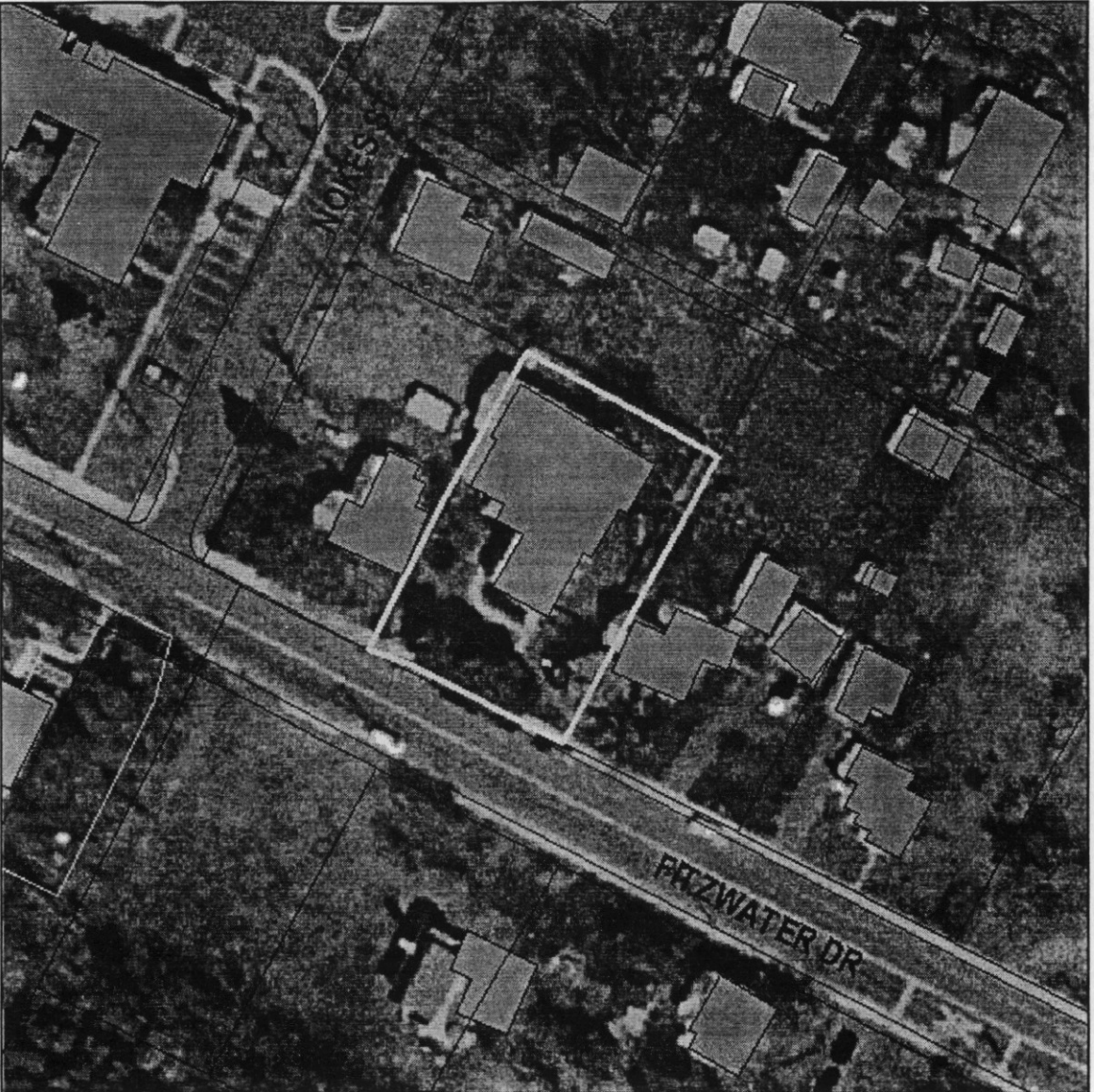

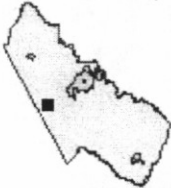
