Hi Bev,

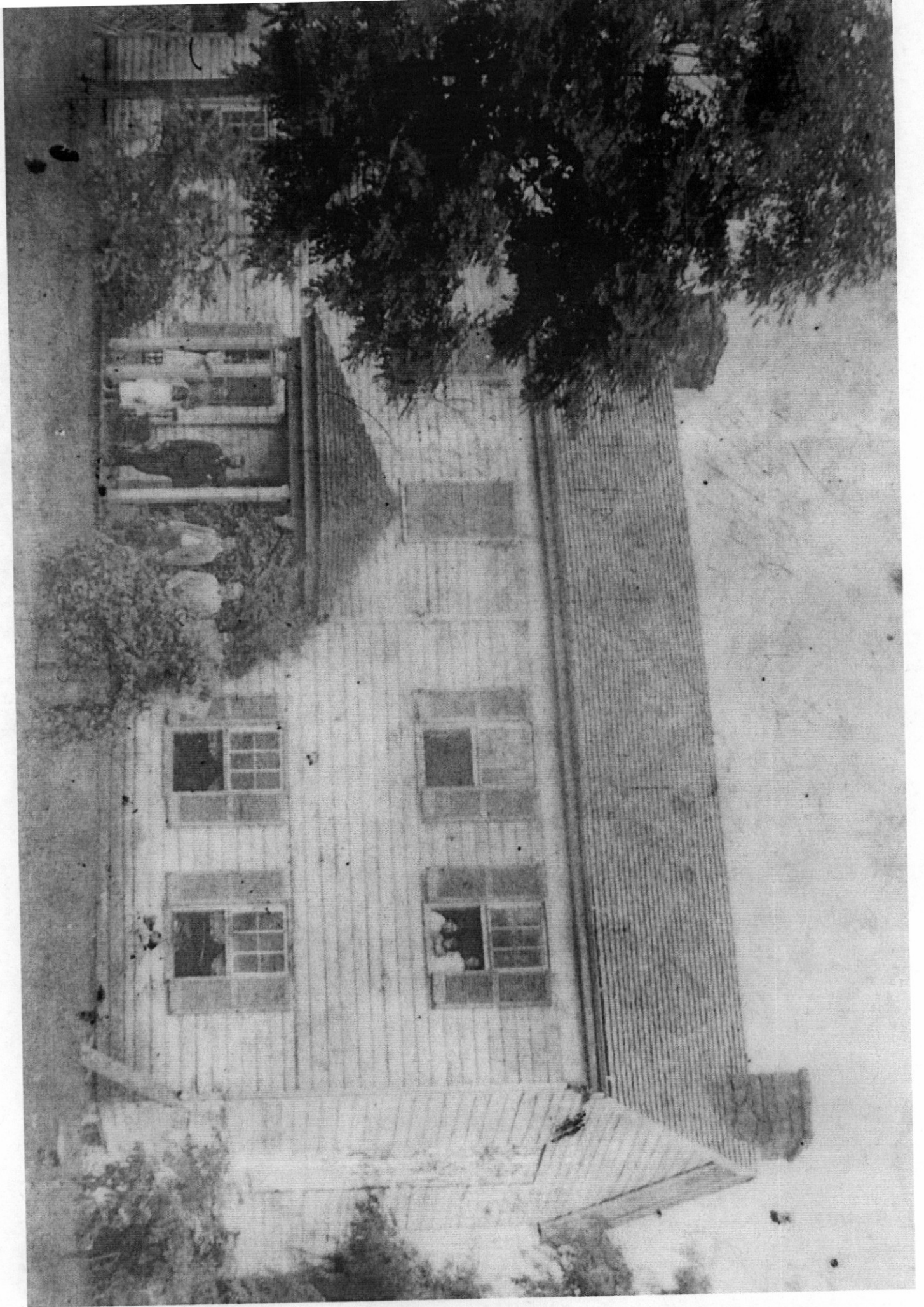
