Description:

This is a two-story, four-bay, frame L-plan dwelling with a hipped roof front porch. There is a stone exterior end chimney with a brick stack on the east end. The house has been renovated and extensively enlarged for use as the golf course clubhouse.

Condition: Remodeled

Threats to Resource: None Known

Additions/Alterations Description:

The front porch is enclosed. There is a shallow one-story lean-to across the back of the I. A two-story, one-bay ell was built on the east side of the original ell. The front of the added ell is behind the stone chimney on the east end of the I and extends some twenty feet beyond the back of the original ell. Most of the L-plan and added ell are clad with asbestos shingles. The roofs are covered with metal standing seam roofing. Most of the windows were replaced 1960 ca. The front of the original house and ell are clad with pressboard siding. This was done when the building was made a club house for the golf course. At that time, one-story additions were built in the east end, the north side, and the south side. A porch was built on the front of the original porch and a covered deck built on the northwest corner.

There is a large, modern, frame golf cart shed located behind (south of) the building. A refreshment stand is located in the parking lot east of the building. There is a larger equipment garage located near a driving range west of the building. There is an early twentieth century concrete block pumphouse located north of the building on the shore of a pond.
