History

Clyde, or Bodine's Mill was built in the 19th century. It appears on the W.H. Brown map of Prince William County, dated 1901.

A merchant flour mill, it was allegedly remodeled in 1911 by John Hall, and again in the '920s by Roy Lunsford. The mill closed in the 1930s. Located on Pioneer Drive below Rocky Run. Prior to the creation of Lake Manassas, Pioneer Drive, or S.R. 657, crossed Broad Run and continued north to Linton Hall Road, S.R. 619.

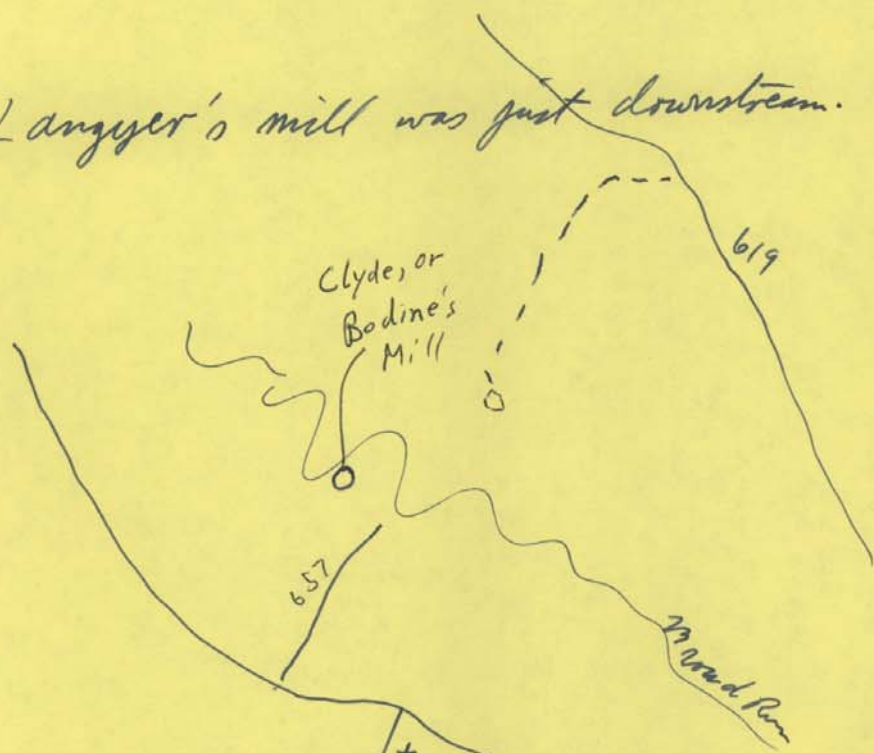
