House faces West. Built to front on London Drive, not RT. 15, which was built about 40 years ago.

Hutchinson recalls that it had a large stone chimney on the north gable end.

Formerly painted white. Siding is 4-5" lap weatherboards. V-notched, with some pegged corners.

Stone nogging

Chimney with mud and mortar. ^{single}

Doors board + batten, front, back + up stairs. Beaded moldings on door along s. wall, frames, window frames, mop boards.

Straight, enclosed box staircase, having its own entrance to outside. Rail missing but mortise holes present -- rectangular, spaced 5 1/4" apart. Nosed treads

Sawn lath throughout interior, partly covered with chipping plaster.

Floors: 8" wide tongue + groove

2d floor: partitioned into 2 rooms -- 1 small 7x12?
one containing stairs and the other larger, c. 9x12.

Roof, 3"x4" cross-cut sawn rafters joined
in a half lap + pinned w/ trunnels.
