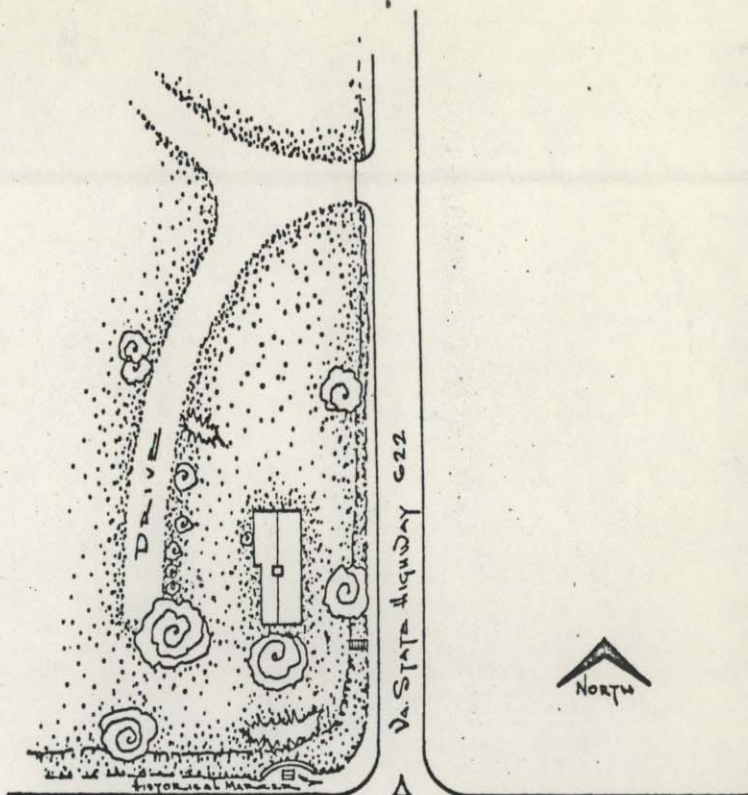


LOCATION MAP

HISTORIC NOTE

At the intersection of the Crovton, Swaley Road (Va G22) and Lee Highway (U.S. 29-211), is located the Dogan House, one of the main landmarks of the second battle of Manassas. It was across this area, on August 29, 1862, that Hooker's Division drove back the Union Division of Hatch before it retired to the east of Crovton. The next day the area was involved in heavy artillery and infantry fire.

The small, one-story house of weather-boarded logs originally served as the overseer's house of the Dogan farm. Later, it was occupied by the Dogan family after their main house had burned. Like the Stone House, it now stands as one of the two remaining original structures of the farm.

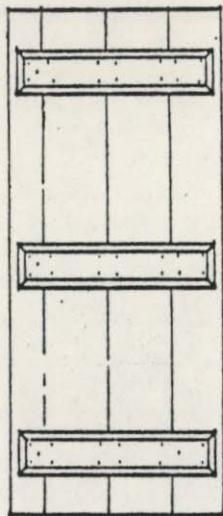

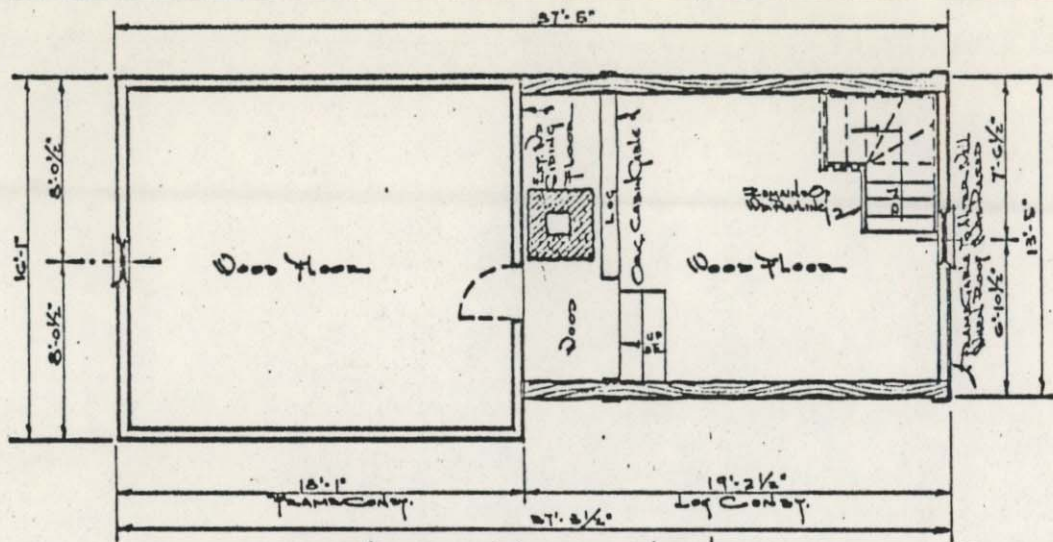

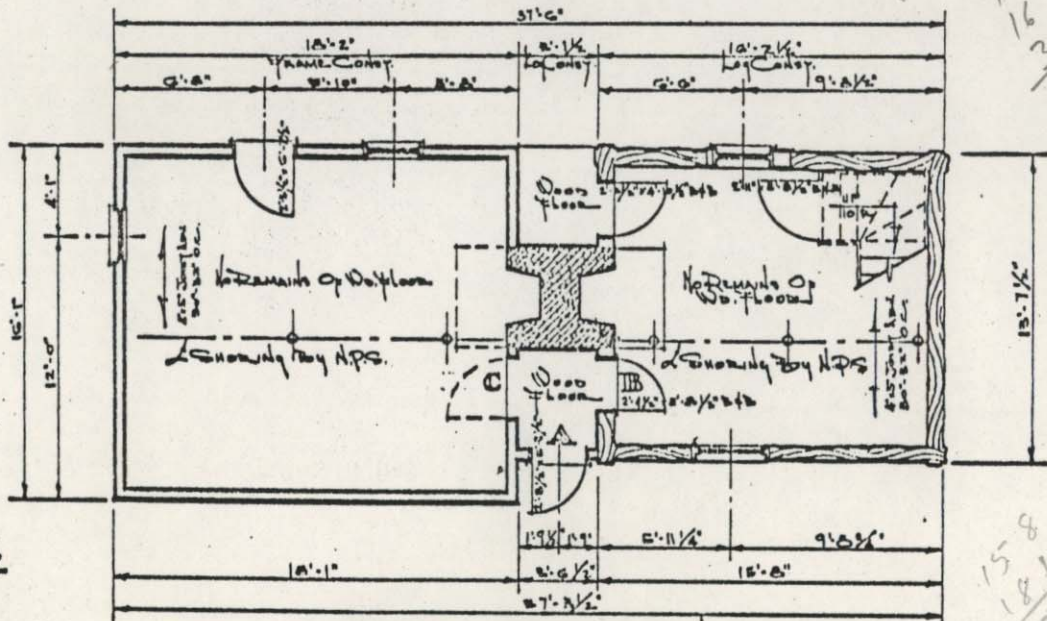

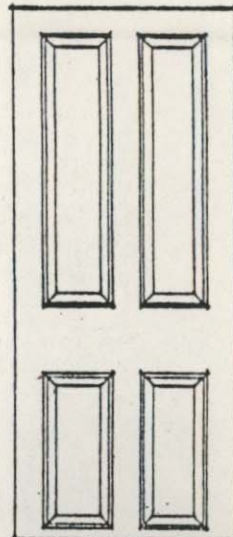

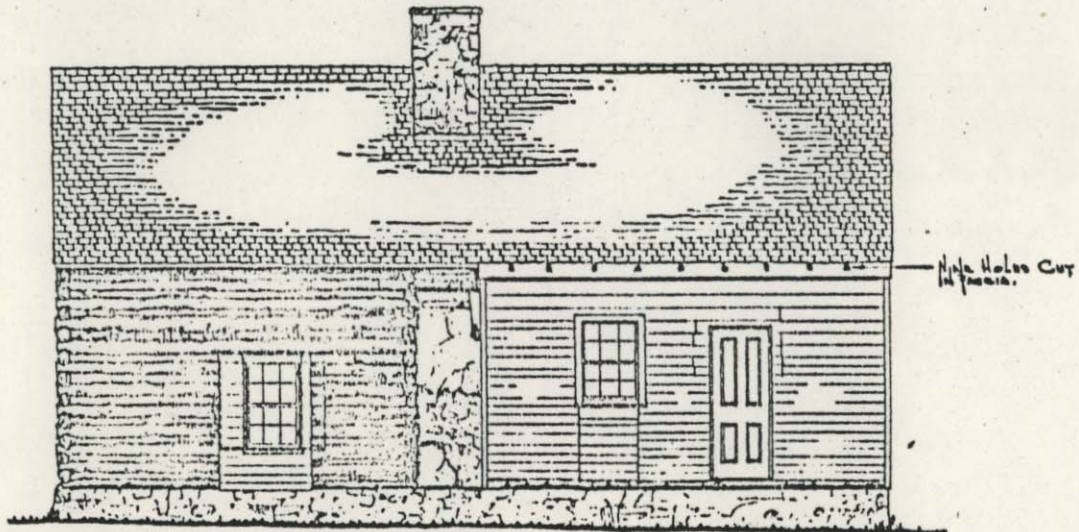




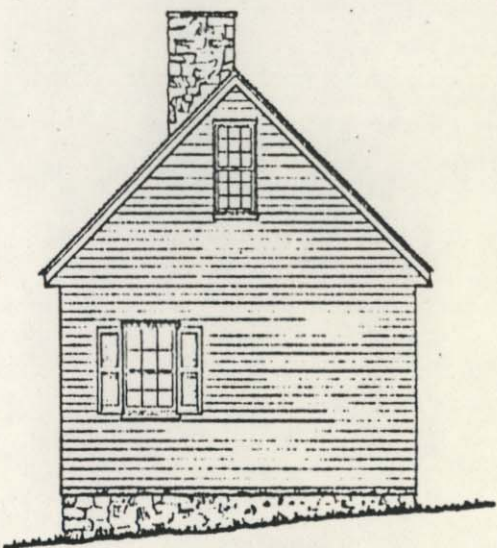
WEST ELEVATION



SOUTH ELEVATION

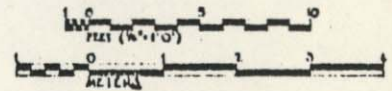


EAST ELEVATION

N.B. - CERTAIN CONJECTURAL RESTORATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE IN DRAWING THESE ELEVATIONS WHERE EVIDENCE INDICATES THEM - MAINLY IN CORRECTING THE BREWERIES IN THE WALLS AND ROOF, IN DRAWING THE WEST BASE, IN INDICATING THE PRESENT SINGLE PILED SASH WINDOWS AS DOUBLE SLIDING, AND IN INDICATING SHUTTING WIRES HINGED SUGGEST THEM, WHERE EVIDENCE IS LACKING CONCERNING THE ORIGINAL APPEARANCE OF SOME FEATURES, SUCH AS THE WINDOW-DOWN ARRANGEMENT OF THE EAST ELEVATION, IT IS DRAWN AS FOUND. THE LOGS ABOVE THE SECOND FLOOR LINE ON THE WEST ELEVATION ARE OF A DIFFERENT CHARACTER, FROM THOSE BELOW, AND ARE CHINKED WITH SMALLER LOGS RATHER THAN WITH HORNS, AS BELOW. JOINTING WITH A 4" x 6" DEAD, 4" x 6" x 6" x 6" TO WEATHER, IS ON THE EAST, NORTH AND SOUTH SIDES OF THE FRAME SECTION, AND AROUND THE EAST WINDOW OF THE LOG SECTION. PLAIN SIDING IS ON THE WEST SIDE OF THE FRAME SECTION, AND ON THE SOUTH GABLE OF THE LOG SECTION.
