 & being in the City aforesaid and bounded as followeth Viz, Beginning on
 the mill branch at a small gum running up s^d branch to Browns line
 thence with Browns line to Thorns Corner at a small branch thence with
 the small branch to the Mill branch thence with the mill branch to
 the Beginning with its appurtenances therunto belonging or anywise
 appertaining. Now the s^d Ruben Cabert & his wife doth warrant
 and forever defend the s^d Land unto the above named Francis Simpson
 to be free from the claim or claims of him the s^d Cabert & wife and
 all and every other person or persons whatsoever. In Witness whereof
