The Polend Place, or Ellen Veil, is a gable-roofed, el-plan farmhouse constructed in three parts. The east end is a stone house ^{containing one room per floor and resting} on a high basement. Attached to that ^{and resting on a stone foundation with no basement,} is a wing ^{built possibly} out of logs ^{is a wing containing} a single room on each floor. On the west end of the frame ^{[or possibly log] wing is a two story ^{frame} addition} built in the early 1900s ^{and containing the kitchen and dining room.} A two-story porch, ~~with an~~ enclosed on the second floor, runs the length of the house's south side, or front, filling in the el.
