notable features cont'd-interior paneling reflects a much earlier period of architecture (ca.1780) and was installed about 20 years ago by the Delashmutt family of Oal Hill.

LOCATION Turn onto county route 601, left off of Rt. 15 North, 4 miles north of Haymarket, Va. Drive .7 miles on route 601, turn right onto Route 630 drive 1 and 1/2 miles to farm gates, turn left into farm road, drive to house.
