to the building thereof

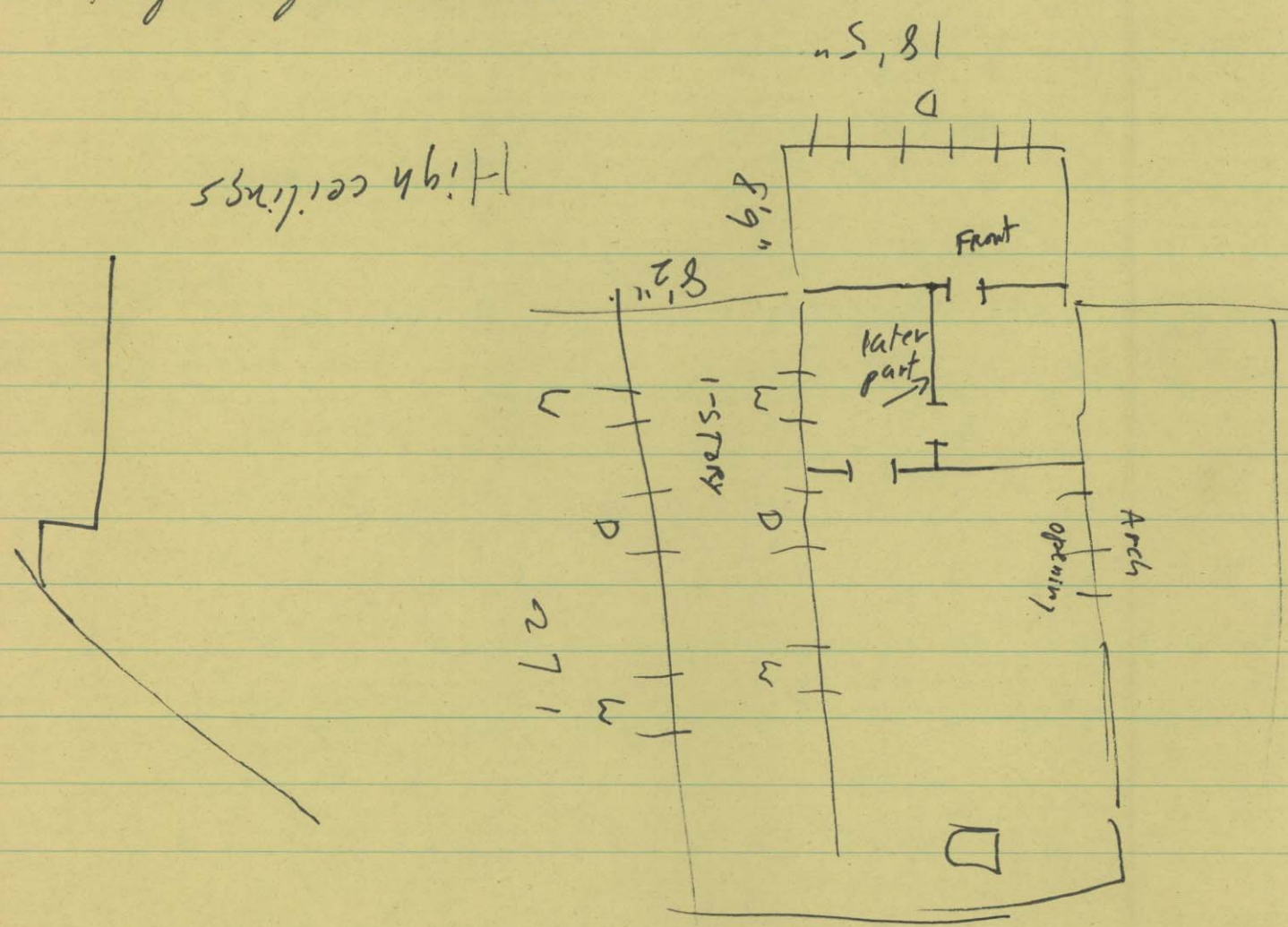
